

## Creation

**At Tables:** Hand out some plasticine to each person. Each person must use some of the plasticine to make their thing. It does not have to be realistic, or the right colour – be creative. Put your things together in the clear dish supplied.  
(Beginners make a plant, animal or person each)

**Say:** Today we are learning how everything started.

### Bible Story

**Show:** Three plants – alive, dead & fake.

**Ask:** What are differences between the 3 plants?

**Say:** People can make fake flowers that are very pretty - but they are only fake, not alive. Only God can give life. He puts life in the little seeds; He puts life in the mother's eggs, so that a baby can grow.

**Say:** In psalm 139:13-16 King David says of God "...you formed me in my mother's womb... ..The days of my life all prepared before I'd even lived one day." David is saying that God made him, before he was born, and that God had plans for David's life, even before he was born.

**Say:** God made you before you were born too, and He has special things planned for your life too.

#### **Return to tables**

Memory Verse: Each table say the memory verse together

**Say:** This term we are going to create magnet worlds. Each week we will make more magnets. We will keep them in a book here, DO NOT DRAW ON THE BOOK, and at the end of the term you can take the magnets home and put them on your fridge. (WE KEEP THE BOOK FOR NEXT TIME)

**Craft:** Magnet book

- Use card board, scissors and a magnet to make a bush, cloud and sun.
- Choose a foam shape from each bag and put a magnet on the back.

**Say:** Satan doesn't want us to believe in God. He likes to tell lies about God. One of his lies is that God did not create the world. Have you heard this lie?

**Say:** No humans were alive when God made the world, so how do we know what happened? God tells us in the Bible.

**Say:** The Bible says that God cannot lie, so if we believe in God, we will trust that what God says about creation is true.

**Finish with Prayer:** Thank God for creating this wonderful world for us.
