

Summary: The first three or four days of creation

Read Before: Genesis 1:1-19; John 1:1-3; Psalms 33:9, Patriarchs and Prophets 44, Bible story V1 13-31

Aim: God created the world

1. *What do I already know?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Use plasticine to create a plant, animal or person

2. *Tell story / give facts.* ☐ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Tell Bible story with felts or magnets. Have someone turn on and off the lights to represent each day,

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Show a dead plant, a live plant and a fake plant.

Ask: What is the difference?

Say: People can make fake flowers that are very pretty but they are not alive. Only God can give life. God gives you life too.

Magnet Books: Sun, cloud, bush, flower etc.

4. *What can this become / what can we do?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Satan doesn't want us to believe in God. He likes to tell lies about God. One of his lies is that God did not create the world. Have you heard this lie?

No humans were alive when God made the world, so how do we know what happened? God tells us in the Bible.

The Bible says that God cannot lie, so if we believe in God, we will trust that what God says about creation is true.
