

Summary: God creates birds, fish and animals. God creates humans in His own image.

Read Before: Genesis 1:20-31; 2:6-25; Patriarchs and Prophets 45-47, Bible story V1 p32-50

Aim: To know what God created on each day. People were created in the image of God.

Game: Have the children walk around in a circle. When the music stops call out something and have them get into groups of the same thing. Start with same colour hair, same colour eyes, shirt, skin etc. Finish with some things they all have in common eg. 2 eyes, a nose, 2 arms, 10 toes etc.

Ask: How come you were all in one group at the end? It's because you're all human! – Humans are supposed to have 2 eyes, 2 arms and 10 toes... and today we are going to find out why.

Tell story using magnet board from last week, and / or act out God forming the man from the ground.

Say: Satan wants us to believe that things just happened by chance, that God had no part in creation, to do this he says that animals lived a long time before people did but the Bible plainly says that animals and people were created on the same day.
