




was the day when He rested from His work of creating.

When Jesus was on earth, He kept the Every Sabbath He went to Church at the Synagogue. If Jesus could help someone by them and making them well on the Sabbath, He did.

In the book of Isaiah 58:13, 14NLT, God says: "Keep the Sabbath day holy. Don't pursue your own interests on that day, but enjoy the Sabbath and speak of it with delight as the Lord's holy day. Honour the Sabbath in everything you do on that day, and don't follow your own desires or talk idly. Then the Lord will be your delight. I will give you great honour... I the Lord have spoken!"



From a human point of view, the Sabbath does not seem important; but to God it is very important. But its importance is not because God needed it, instead, God made the Sabbath to be a blessing for people and perhaps a test.

In Mark 2:27 $_{\rm NLT}$ Jesus said, "**The Sabbath was made to meet the needs of people**" – God did not make people because the Sabbath needed people to worship it!

When Revelation talks about the small group of people who love Jesus at the end of the world, it says they "**Keep the commandments of God.**" Revelation $14:12_{K \text{ IV}}$

The Ten Commandments of God are found in Exodus 20 and Deuteronomy 5. We get our months because that's how long it takes for the moon to go around the


earth: the full moon to new moon and back to the full moon, giving us the tides of the sea.


