Summary: Adam and Eve choose sin; Gods plan for salvation

Read Before: Genesis 2:8-17; 3; Luke 10:18; Is 14:12-14; Eze 28:14-17; Rev 12:7-9; Patriarchs and Prophets 33-43; Bible story V1 61-77, V2 6-15

Aim: Sin leads to death. God promised to send Jesus to save Adam, Eve and me from dying forever. We have a choice to make.

1. What do I already know? □ Listen / Talk □ See ☑ Do

Choosing game: Go around the circle, give each child a choice of two coloured cards (have different points for different colours written on the backs of the cards but don't show them) – total up the scores at the end.

Who made the best choice and won?

Play again.

2. Tell story / give facts. □ Listen / Talk ☑ See □ Do

Bible story: Contrast Tree of Life to the Tree of Knowledge of Good and Evil. Conclude with: Jesus could no longer visit them and they had to leave the garden. But God had a plan...

3. Review / how does it apply today?

4. What can this become / what can we do?

Because of Adam and Eve's choice, everyone since then has been born with a sinful nature. That makes it really easy for us to sin.

But with Jesus help we can choose to make the right choice and when we do fail, we can ask Jesus to forgive us and to help us next time.
