Later, God asked Cain, "Where is your brother?" "How should I know?" Cain said.


Then God said, "What have you done? You have murdered your brother, now you must leave. You will not be a farmer any more; from now on you will be a homeless wanderer."


Cain cried "My punishment is too great! Anyone who finds me will kill me!"




