Summary: Adam and Eve leave the garden and have two children. God asks for sacrifices to point to Jesus. Cain disobeys and is jealous of Abel and kills him.

Read Before: Genesis 4:1-16; 5:3-5, 18-24; Patriarchs and Prophets 71-89; Bible story V1 79-98

Aim: 1. I show my love for God by obeying. 2. Sibling rivalry
