Read Before: Exodus 1:6-14, 22; 2:1-10 Patriarchs and Prophets 241-246; Bible Story V2 75-88

Craft: Double bed

Optional: Pillow – Layer: thin satin face down, then thin quilting, then another lay of satin face up. Squash the layers together with a metal ruler and then run a hot soldering iron along the edge of the ruler. The heat will cut the layers and also join the layers which are held down by the ruler. Better yet, get someone to help and hold to rulers next to each other with only enough gap for the soldering iron to fit between. Solder the layers into strips and then small rectangles for pillows.
