

Summary: Moses tries to help the Israelites by killing an Egyptian and has to flee. Many years later, God speaks to him from the burning bush.

Read Before: Exodus 2:11-25; 3 Patriarchs and Prophets 246-253; Bible Story V2 89-99

Aim: 1. I should wait for God's timing and not be impatient. 2. Reverence for God.

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☒ Do

Pictionary: (Sit, pray, sing, listen, walk, run etc.) When you think your group has the answer say "Stop!" If the answer is wrong you can't guess again until next time.

Ask: Did you speak too soon? Were you impatient?

Craft: Mat – something to kneel on beside your bed.

Option 1: Cut squares of a loose weave fabric, use large needles to stitch string or wool across them.

Option 2: Cut ovals from light cardboard, fold in half and cut several slits from the fold to 1cm of the edge, unfold. The children can weave wool or ribbon through the slits.
