

**Summary:** The people complain and God makes water come from the rock. Moses holds up his hands while they fight the Amalekites. Jethro advises Moses to organise leaders among the people so he is free for important matters.

**Read Before:** Exodus 17; 18; Patriarchs and Prophets 297-301; Bible story V2 146-150

**Aim:** The Israelites needed to learn to trust God for their needs; we can trust God for our needs.

**Ask:** How many times do your parents have to remind you to do something before you learn to do it yourself?

**Say:** What did the Israelites need last week? What did God do about it?

**Say:** Today we will learn about some other things they needed and see if they had learnt their lesson.

**Tell story with felts, or whiteboard, or act out or use a Bible book with pictures**

**Say:** The Israelites kept forgetting to trust God, so God had them make a special church called the Sanctuary or Tabernacle; this church was something that the people could look at to learn more about God and how He planned to save people from sin. This term we will each be making a book about the Sanctuary.

**Ask:** Do you ever wish that you could ask God stuff? Like Why did Jesus have to die? Why does He let bad things happen? Why does Satan want to hurt people? What does sin really mean? How did Jesus dying on the cross save us?

**Say:** The Sanctuary was God's way of teaching the Israelites, and although we don't need Moses' Sanctuary any more, it can still teach us a lot about sin and how God saves us.
