When the people of Moab saw the Israelites camped near their country they were scared. King Balak sent a message to Balaam, a prophet of God, saying, "Please come, I will pay you to curse these people for me because they are too powerful for me, then maybe we will be able to force them from our land."

Balaam knew the Israelites were God's people, and that God would not want him to curse them, but he asked the messengers to say the night.

That night God spoke to Balaam and said, "Do not go with them; you are not to curse these people, because I have blessed them!"

The next morning Balaam told the officials, "Go on home! God will not let me go with you."

Then King Balak sent more officials and promised to pay very well. Balaam said, "Stay here tonight and I will ask God again."

That night God came to Balaam and told him, "You may go with them; but you must only say what I tell you to say."

The next morning Balaam saddled his donkey and started off; maybe he was thinking of the money he might get paid. Suddenly his donkey ran off the road into a field; the donkey had seen an angel standing in the road with a sword in his hand. Balaam couldn't see the angel, so he hit his donkey and turned it back onto the road.

Then the angel stood at a place where the road narrowed between two walls; the donkey squeezed past and crushed Balaam's foot against the wall. Finally, the angel stood in a place too narrow for the donkey to get by, so the donkey lay down. Balaam was very angry and kept hitting the poor donkey until the donkey started talking. It said, "Why did you hit me?"

"You have made me look like a fool in front of the officials!" Balaam shouted, "If I had a sword, I would kill you!"

All of a sudden, Balaam was able to see the angel.

Balaam said, "I have sinned, I will go home now."

The angel told Balaam to go with the officials, but when King Balak asked him to curse Israel, he couldn't, and blessed them instead.

Friday

If the High Priest sinned he had to sacrifice a bull as a sin offering. If one of the Israelite leaders sinned, they must bring a male goat to be sacrificed for their sin offering. Anyone other Israelite, was bring a female goat or sheep, or if they couldn't afford that, then two turtledoves or pigeons, or some flour. And as the blood from the sacrificed animal was placed on the horns of the altar, the Israelite knew that their sins had been placed with it and they were forgiven.

The sacrificial system ended with the death of Jesus. Now we can come directly to God.



Monday

Unfortunately, the story of Balaam doesn't end there. Balaam didn't repent of his greed and spend the rest of his life serving God. Instead, it appears that Balaam left the service of God, and came up with another plan for Balak, so that Israel would be cursed.

In Revelation 2:14, the angel told John to write to the church in Pergamum, telling them that they had people there who were following the teaching of Balaam. The angel mentions that Balaam showed Balak how to trick the people of Israel, causing them to sin by luring them with food offered to idols and with beautiful, idol-worshipping, women. Jude 1:11 says Balaam, deceived people for money.

The death of Balgam is recorded in Joshua 13:22 when the Israelites were clearing the Promised Land of idol worshipers, and unlike the beginning of the story of Balaam where he talked to God, it says he used magic to tell the future. NLT

Sin, whether it be greed, like Balaam, or any other sin is a big deal, and the services of the Sanctuary were designed to help the Israelites understand this.

Every morning and every evening the priests would sacrifice a lamb as a burnt offering, reminding the people that one day Jesus would come to die for sin.

When a person released that they had sinned in a particular way, then they were to bring a sin offering for themselves to the Sanctuary. The blood from the sin offering was placed on the horns of the Altar of Sacrifice in the courtyard and sprinkled on the horns of the Altar of Incense inside and from this, the sinner understood that their sins had been moved to the Sanctuary and they were forgiven.




