


Every morning and evening the priest offered a perfect, 1-year-old lamb as a burnt offering on the altar of sacrifice. This lamb reminded the people that Jesus, God's perfect Son, would one day die for them.

The blood from the sin offering was used in the sanctuary in two ways.

- 1. Inside the sanctuary, it was placed on the horns of the Altar of Incense and sprinkled before the curtain.
- 2. It was placed on the horns of the Altar of Sacrifice.

The sinner then understood that their sins were moved to the sanctuary.





Other sacrifices were also made on the altar, including personal offerings that people brought when they knew they had sinned.
