

Two months after the Israelites left Egypt, they arrived in the wilderness of Sinai and set up camp near the Mountain and Moses climbed the mountain to talk to God.


God said, "If Israel will obey me they will be my own special people."

When Moses told the people they said, "We will do everything the Lord has commanded "

Then the Lord said to Moses, "I will come in a thick cloud so the people can hear me speak; tell them to get ready, and to wash their clothes. Mark off a boundary all around the mountain; warn the people not to go up on the mountain or even touch the boundary."

Three days later, thunder roared and lightning flashed, and a thick cloud covered the mountain. Smoke billowed into the sky and the whole mountain shook! There was a long, loud blast from a ram's horn and Moses led the people to meet God at the bottom of the mountain.

Then God said, "I am the Lord your God, who rescued you from slavery," and He gave them ten rules or commandments to live by.



"You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind, for I am a jealous God who will not tolerate your affection for any other gods."

"You must not misuse the name of the Lord..."

"Remember to observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. You have six days each week for your ordinary work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath day of rest dedicated to the Lord your God. On that day no one in your house may do any work...



For in six days the Lord made the heavens, the earth, the sea, and everything in them; but on the seventh day He rested. That is why the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy."

"Honour your father and mother." "You must not murder."

"You must not commit adultery." "You must not steal."

"You must not testify falsely against your neighbour."

"You must not covet your neighbour's house, or anything that belongs to your neighbour." (Ten Commandments abbreviated from Exodus 20:17_{NLT})

What makes the 10 Commandments so special?

The people heard God speak them! It is not often that large groups of people hear God speaking out loud. Another time something like that happened was when Jesus was baptised; you might like to look it up in Matthew 3:13-17.

<u>God wrote them with His own hand!</u> The Bible records many time where God gave messages to His prophets who then wrote them down and passed them on to the people. But this time, God didn't just leave them to Moses to write, He wrote them Himself.

Later this term you will learn that not only were the 10 Commandments spoken and written on stone by God, but stones that God wrote on were kept in a very special place.


Jesus said, "If you love me obey my Commandments."


