

There is an old saying:


Tell me and I will forget. Show me and I will remember. Involve me and I will understand.

# Monday

God knew that the Israelites needed something they could see and do in their worship, but His plan never involved idols! - They could see the pillar of cloud and fire, which shaded the camp by day, provided light at night and led them whenever they travelled from place to place and now He was planning something else for them but they were too impatient to wait!

God's plans never involve idols; God knows that when people pray in front of something, whether it is a picture, a statue, an object or an animal; that even if people start out praying to God, they will eventually forget they are praying to God and what they pray in front of will become an idol.


Fit the underlined words of the 1st and 2nd Commandments from Exodus  $20:3-5_{NLT}$  into the grid.


God had a plan for something the

When Jesus died on the cross, an angel tore the curtain in the Sanctuary from top to bottom to show that the animal sacrifices were no longer necessary; Jesus had died and taken the punishment for sin once and for all. Yet participating or seeing and doing as a part of worship is still important today.
