


The Walls




The wall panels were made from Acacia wood covered in gold and each panel had 2 silver bases. There were 20 panels along each of the long sides, and 8 across the back of the Sanctuary. Exodus 36:20-34

The walls represent Jesus

**The wood shows that Jesus became a human
Gold shows that Jesus was also God**

Four pillars held the curtain in the middle of the Sanctuary, they were made from acacia wood covered in gold and had silver bases. Exodus 36:36



Five pillars held the curtain at the front of the Sanctuary; they were also acacia wood covered with gold, but they had bronze bases.

Exodus 36:37, 38

The curtains were blue, purple and red, with designs sewn into them, possibly of angels.

They were attached to the pillars by golden hooks. Exodus 36:35, 37

The Roof


The coverings of the Sanctuary are found in Exodus 36:8, 14, 19

The outside layer was leather.

The next layer was ram skins, dyed red.

Then a layer of goats hair, dyed white.

The inside layer was like the curtains; blue, purple and red.
