Read Before: Exodus 27; Leviticus 16; Patriarchs and Prophets 347-358

Aim: The Sanctuary and its services give me a picture of Jesus

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Have to adults do a skit of a married couple, or two people, one of whom talks so much that the other person can never say anything.

Ask: Will they be good friends? Do they each know what the other is thinking?

Say: To have a real friendship there must be two-way communication.

Sanctuary book:

1. The altar of incense

Ask: How do we talk to Jesus? How do we listen to Jesus?

Say: Jesus wants to be our best friends, and if we want Him to be our friend we must remember to talk and to listen to Him every day; lets talk to Jesus now...
