Summary: To learn about the priests and their clothes. Nadab and Abihu get drunk and disobey God in the Sanctuary and are punished by death.

Read Before: Exodus 28, 29; Leviticus 8; 10:1-11; Patriarchs and Prophets 350, 351, 359, 362; The Bible Story V2, 188-192.

Aim: 1. The priests teach us about Jesus. 2. People who are older or hold positions of responsibility need to set a good example and will often receive a bigger punishment. 3. We need to respect God's church.

Say: When someone who holds an important job does the wrong thing, lots of people see, if they aren't punished then lots of people would think it is OK to break the laws. For this reason, their punishment is often worse than if someone who doesn't hold an important job does it.

Say: The priest had one of the most important positions of responsibility in Israel. He showed the people what God was like. That is why God had to punish Nadab and Abihu.

Ask: How can you be a good example for younger children?
