

Summary: 12 spies are sent: 10 give bad reports, 2 give good reports. The people listen to the 10 bad, so God says they must turn back. The next day they decided to go forward anyway and are chased back.

Read Before: Numbers 13:1-3, 17-33; 14; Patriarchs and Prophets 387-394; Bible Story V3, 26-31

Aim: 1. To trust and obey God. 2. To be a good witness for God.

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Look at the pictures under red cellophane; then under yellow cellophane.

Red = What we see; Yellow = What God sees.

(I stapled the cellophane to a circle of cardboard – test it, you might want to use a double layer)

Hand out the parts of the story (story.pdf) – have different children read what each spy said as you tell the story.
