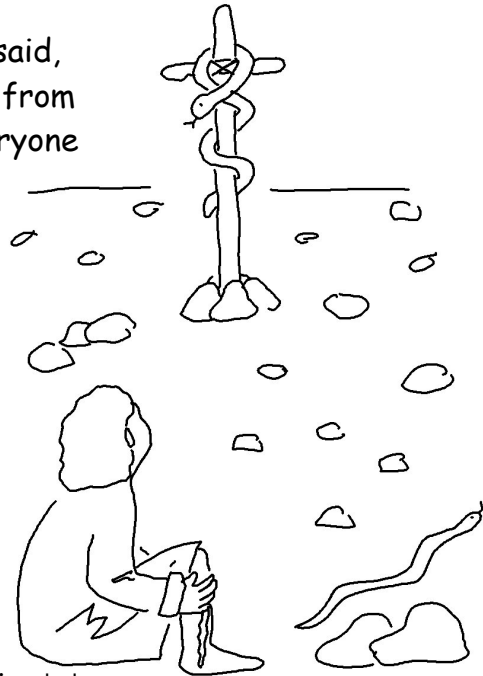
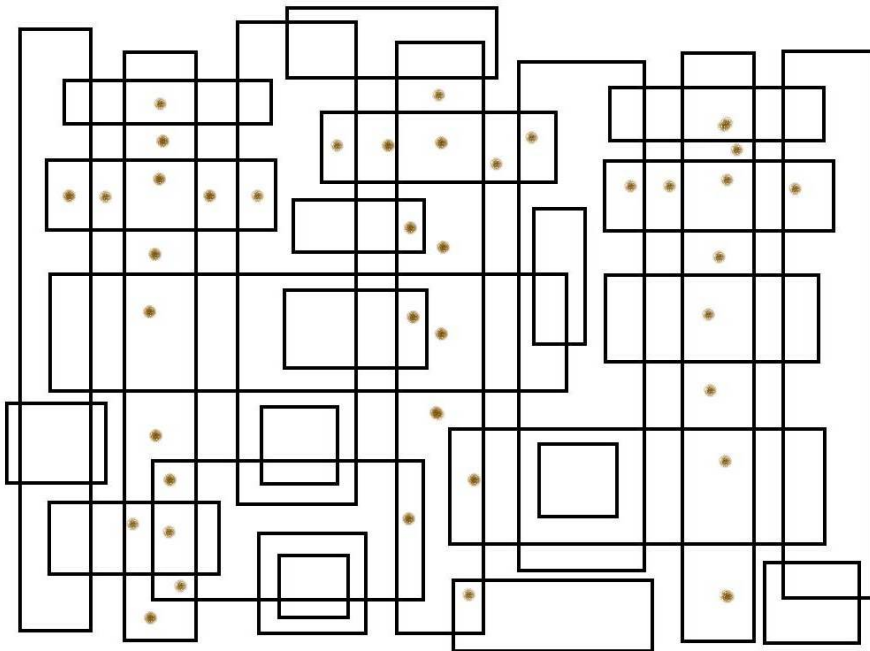

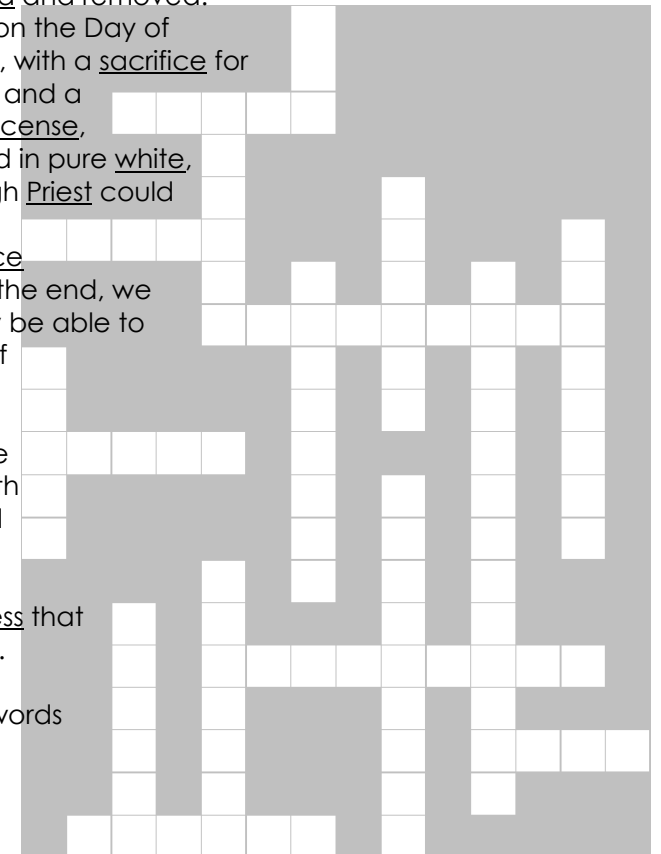

Being angry is not a sin - it is a normal part of being human. Becoming angry should motivate us to do something about whatever is wrong - not to do something else that is wrong.

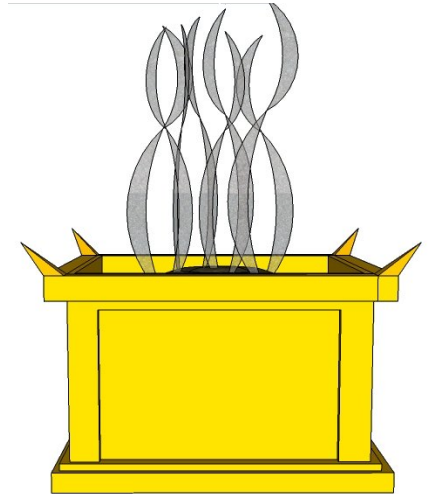

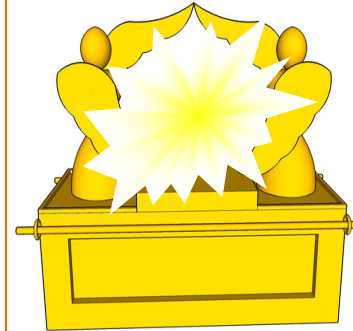

Monday

The Altar of Burnt Offerings was located in the courtyard of the Sanctuary and, like the snake on the pole, reminded the people that Jesus would one day die for sin. This is where the various sacrifices were burnt, including the daily sacrifices for the sins of Israel and the personal sacrifices that people brought as sin offerings.

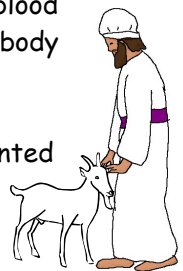


The Day of Atonement, Yom Kippur in Hebrew, occurred in autumn on the tenth day of the seventh Jewish month. On this day the High Priest would remove his colourful robes, wash, and dress in pure white. He would offer a ram as a burnt offering and then sacrifice a bull as a sin offering for his family. Taking the blood of the bull, and a burner of incense, the High Priest would enter the Most Holy Place to sprinkle the blood in front of the atonement cover or mercy seat of the Ark.



Two male goats would be presented to the Lord, and lots cast to determine which would represent the sacrifice of Jesus. This goat was killed, and the High Priest sprinkled its blood above the atonement cover of the Ark before burning its body on the Altar of Sacrifice.

The other goat was called the scapegoat and represented Satan. The priest put his hands on that goat and confessed Israel's sins. Then the priest sent the goat into the wilderness, never to return. One day Satan and sin will be gone from this world, never to return.

Wednesday

Hebrews 9 talks about the services of the Old Testament Sanctuary and how they pointed to the Sacrifice of Christ and the work that He performs for us. Use an NLT or NIV Bible to find the missing words and solve the crossword.

Hebrews 9:11, 12, 28 "So Christ has now become the _ _ _ (4a) _ _ _ _ (6a) over all the good things that have come. He has entered that greater, more perfect _ _ _ _ _ (8d) in _ _ _ _ _ (9a), which was not made by _ _ _ _ (5d) _ _ _ _ (11d) and is not part of this created world. With His own blood—not the blood of goats and calves—He entered the Most Holy Place _ _ _ _ (1d) for all time and secured our _ _ _ _ _ (7a) forever. ²⁸Christ was offered _ _ _ _ (13d) for all time as a sacrifice to take away the _ _ _ _ (2d) of _ _ _ _ (3a) people. The rock that Moses struck can also be seen as a symbol of Christ.

In Deuteronomy 32:3,4 Moses sings, "I will proclaim the name of the _ _ _ _ (14a); how glorious is our God! He is the _ _ _ _ (10a); His deeds are _ _ _ _ _ (6d)." NLT
