## Lesson Plan

**Summary:** Goliath challenges Israel's army and insults God; David is visiting his brothers and fights Goliath.

Read Before: 1 Samuel 17; Patriarchs and Prophets p643-648; The Bible Story V4, p9-13

Aim: We can do great things if God is helping us

1. What do I already know? ☐ Listen / Talk ☑ See ☑ Do

Find out who the tallest child is and measure them.

Michael Jordan the basketball player is 1.95m tall; compare this to Goliath at approx 3m according to some versions of the Bible.

2. Tell story / give facts. ☐ Listen / Talk ☑ See ☐ Do

Tell story using craft booklet or Bible Story DVD

3. Review / how does it apply today? □ Listen / Talk □ See ☑ Do

Craft: Make a booklet to tell the story of David and Goliath. Practice telling the story.

Ask: Could we say that David was in God's army? (Yes) Say: If we obey God then we can be part of God's army too.

Sing or learn the song: "I'm in the Lord's army" Can also sing: "Only a boy named David"

**4.** What can this become / what can we do? 
☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Optional Craft: Have children draw or colour pictures of themselves in God's army – can paste on a poster with the words to the song above.

Discuss: how we can be in God's army. Can tie into the 3<sup>rd</sup> Commandments – Satan wants us to disrespect God, we can fight Satan by being respectful to God and encouraging those around us to do the same.
