Lesson Plan

Summary: The Israelites fight the Amorites, God sends hail to help them and when Joshua prays, the sun doesn't set.

Read Before: Joshua 10:1-15; Patriarchs and Prophets 507-509; The Bible Story V3, 99-104

Aim: 1. God will help us do what He asks. 2. God is powerful

1. What do I already know? □ Listen / Talk ☑ See □ Do

Look at a book on the sun or solar system. Show a picture of the sun. Ask: What is this? What do you know about it? (The earth travels around the sun, how large is it, how hot etc?)

2. Tell story / give facts. I Listen / Talk I See I Do

Tell story with felts

Do the "Building Understanding" from the "Primary Teaching Guide" Have a bag containing various objects (pic of sun, potato, crown, praying hands, pencil, calculator, moon etc.) – have the children select an item from the bag and say if it was in the story.

Have an adult tell a personal story of a time they have asked God for help.

Ask the children if they have evern been afraid? Did they ask God for help?

Talk about situations that might scare us.
