**Aim:** 1. God will help us do what He asks. 2. God is powerful

**Look at a book on the sun or solar system.**

**Show a picture of the sun. Ask: What is this? What do you know about it? (The earth travels around the sun, how large is it, how hot etc?)**

**Have a bag containing various objects (pic of sun, potato, crown, praying hands, pencil, calculator, moon etc.) – have the children select an item from the bag and say if it was in the story.**
