


The Judges

<u>Sunday</u>

The job of removing the remaining Canaanites continued even after <u>Joshua</u> died. Do you remember <u>Caleb</u>, Joshua's friend and fellow spy? Caleb was growing old too, but still had the town of Kiriath-sepher to capture, so he promised that the man who captured it, could marry his daughter Acsah. Othniel, his nephew did and when Othniel and Acsah were married, Acsah also asked her father for the gift of a field and a spring and he gladly gave them.

The other tribes were clearing their lands too but instead of completely removing the idol worshipping Canaanites as God had commanded, some tribes made slaves of them.

But under the influence of the Canaanites living among them, many of the Israelites started to worship idols; so God allowed King <u>Cushan-</u><u>rishathaim</u> of <u>Aram</u> to make the Israelites slaves for eight years. Then God called <u>Othniel</u> to become a judge; to call the people back to worshipping God and to lead them to victory over their enemies.

But forty years later when Othniel died, the people again forgot God. So King <u>Eglon</u> of <u>Moab</u> to make them slaves for eighteen years until they turned back to God. Then <u>Ehud</u>, a left-handed man from Benjamin led the Israelites to victory and for eighty years there was peace.

Not all of the judges were men. <u>Deborah</u> was a prophet of God and a judge. When the people turned to God after twenty years under King <u>Jabin</u> and his army commander <u>Sisera</u>, God sent a message through Deborah to <u>Barak</u> to lead the Israelites to victory. But Barak was afraid and asked Deborah to go with him. She agreed, but said that because of his lack of faith, the honour would not be his."

God gave them a great victory that day but Sisera escaped. He stopped at the camp of Heber the Kennite, where Heber's wife <u>Jael</u> gave him a drink and helped him hide under a blanket. When he fell asleep, she took a hammer and stuck a tent peg through his temple. Then Deborah the prophet composed a song in memory of what God had done and how Jael had stopped Sisera.


<u>Friday</u>

It probably seems silly to you to worship the sun or an



When people become superstitious, it seems to them that more bad things happened when they didn't perform certain rituals or worship activities, and more good things seem to happen when they do. So they come to believe that their gods have power and that they can influence their luck by how they worship their gods.

Although idols are not as common in our society, we can break the first Commandment just as easily today.

People who worship idols will give money, food or other things as sacrifices to their god. They will spend time everyday doing things for their god, perhaps repeating special words. Without realising,

people today can be giving a significant amount of their time and money to something which, although it is not an idol-statue has become a god to them.

Gideon said "Show me a sign - wait here until I come back." Quickly, he went home to get some meat, bread and broth.



When he returned, the angel of God, for that is who the stranger was, said to him, "Place the meat and the bread on this rock, and pour the broth over it."

Gideon did as he was told, then the angel touched the meat and bread with the tip of his staff and fire

flared up from the rock and burned them up. Then the angel disappeared.

That night the Lord said to Gideon, "Pull down the altar to the idol Baal, then build an altar to the Lord here on this hilltop. Take the second

bull from your father's herd, and sacrifice it as a burnt offering." So Gideon took ten servants and did as the Lord had commanded, but he did it at night because he was afraid of what the town's people would do.



The next morning, the people discovered their idol was gone; they soon found out that Gideon was responsible and demanded that he be brought out and stoned to death.

But Joash, Gideon's father said, "Why are you defending Baal? If Baal is really a god, let him come and destroy the one who broke down his altarl"
