

Summary: Many years pass after Joshua's death and the Israelites forget God and worship idols; the Midianites keep raiding. When they pray for help God calls Gideon and tells him to destroy the idol.

Read Before: Judges 6:1-32; Patriarchs and Prophets 543-548; The Bible Story V3, 115-120

Aim: Even when we disobey God hears us, forgives and helps us. Gideon's first job was to remove the idols.

Play Pictionary by drawing objects that have been seen as gods: sun, earth, volcano, cats, cows, bear, whale, dog, horse, elephant, Jesus.

Ask: Can you guess what all these things have to do with each other?

Say: Different people at different times, have thought that each of these things were gods. Today we will find out what happened when the Israelites started worshipping other gods.

Act out the story or tell with felts or pictures from The Bible Story

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Say: Different people have worshiped all sorts of gods at different times.

Look: at the pictures from the first Pictionary – written on some of the pictures is a country where that thing has been worshiped.

Say: People think that their gods are very important; they spend time with their gods, and give things to their gods. They do the things that they think their god wants them to do.

Say: Most people in Australia don't worship animals or the sun or volcanos, but there are other things that people treat like gods.

Pictionary 2: Ask: Do some people treat this thing like a god? (TV, football, racing, laptop, ipad etc)

Make a model or draw a picture of your favourite thing to do.

Ask: Do you treat this thing a bit like a god? What should you do to make sure that it doesn't become a god to you?
