Game: Charades

Ask: Do you remember how we learnt about Hannah last week?

Say: Today we are learning about Hannah's son and a little about the chores that he did.

Return to tables

Memory Verse: Fill in the blanks and then say the memory verse on the colouring page.

Being Helpful Sheet: Put a tick next to the children who are being helpful and cross out those who are not being helpful

Craft: Make a picture for Mum (or Dad) to tell them what you will do to help them.

- Glue the vase at the bottom of the paper.
- Glue one or two flowers.
- Choose the things that you want to do this week to help Mum or Dad, and glue them in the centre of the flowers.
- Draw stems and leaves.
- Add a small flower sticker.

Discuss the following depending on age, interest and time:

What sort of things do you think Samuel did?

Do you think Samuel was ever tired?

Do you think Samuel ever complained?

What things do you already do to help at home?

What other things could you do?

Do you think it shows that you love Mum when you complain about your chores? (no)

The 5th Commandment says to "honour" your parents – what does honour mean? (respect)

How can you show respect with your mouth? Your eyes? Your body language?

Read and discuss Proverbs 20:11

Finish with Prayer: As a group pray that God will help us to do the things we have chosen without having to be asked and with out complaining. (If there is time give the children time to pray silently about it as well.
