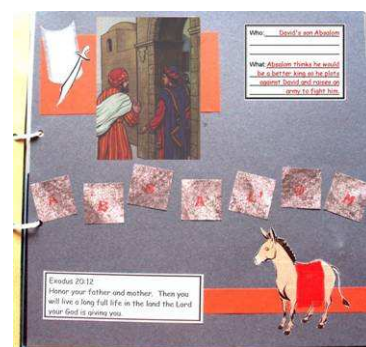
Scenario: A student who never gets picked – discuss what each person is thinking.
