Summary: Jesus preaches from a boat and then tells the fishermen to cast their nets again. They catch two boat loads, then Jesus calls them to be fishers of men.

Read Before: Luke 5:1-11, Desire of Ages 244-251, Bible Story V7 p169 - 173

Aim: Jesus called the disciples to follow Him & work for Him. You can work for Jesus too.

1. What do I already know?
☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Ask: The children what their parents do for a living. Talk about the different types of jobs that people can have. Could even ask what they want to do when they grow up.

2. Tell story / give facts. □ Listen / Talk ☑ See □ Do

Tell story: with felts to illustrate.

3. Review / how does it apply today? ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☑ Do

Ask: How many fish had they caught all night? (None)

Ask: How many fish did they catch when Jesus told them to do it? (Two full boat loads)

Ask: What did Jesus tell them to do next? (Follow Him & fish for people)

Pillow covers: glue fish and add "fishing net" (netting) on top.

4. What can this become / what can we do? □ Listen / Talk □ See ☑ Do

Fishing Game: Print the fish onto cardboard. (You can print "back-to-back" to make the fish double sided). Put a large paperclip on the nose of each fish. Make a fishing line with a stick (or long barbeque skewer) with a magnet on the end of the line.

Say: When we are following Jesus we will be these things that are written on these fish. (Kind, Helpful, happy, obedient and loving.)

Play a game: With 2 or more of each fish in a bowl, take turns trying to catch 2 of the same fish.
