f you live in Darien, Connecticut, you rely on teenagers to save your life. For 25 years Explorer Post 53, a division of the Boy Scouts of America, has had total responsibility for the town's ambulance service. Sixty teenage volunteers provide 24-hour emergency medical service. They're pretty busy, too, answering more than 1,000 emergency calls every year.

When the volunteers turn 14, they are given extensive firstaid training and are supervised by adult volunteers and paramedics, who do the tough medical procedures and give the medications. The teens train to be radio dispatchers, emergency medical technicians (EMTs), drivers, and crew chiefs.

The people in the town of Darien count on teenagers to help them in an emergency. In the same way, the people of your town and school rely on you to save them.

"But I don't have any medical training," you say.

Maybe not, but you have something even more important. You have training in eternal lifesaving skills. You know Jesus in a way that many people don't. You can help them to know Jesus too. You can answer their questions and rescue them from the disease of sin by bringing them to the Great Physician.

Won't you join God's volunteer lifesaving rescue squad now?

- What does witnessing mean to you? When do you feel like you're witnessing? What kinds of witnessing are there? How is witnessing like being a volunteer in a rescue squad?
- Ask your pastor about getting some information on friendship evangelism. Maybe he or she will teach a class especially geared for you and your friends.

Sunday

The same night that Jesus was born, shepherds were staying in the fields nearby, looking after their sheep. Suddenly, the sky became bright, and they saw an angel in front of them. They were scared, but the angel said to them, "Don't be afraid! I have good news for you. News that will bring great joy to everyone! The Saviour, Jesus, has been born today in Bethlehem! Design a Christian t-shirt that would make people ask questions so that the person wearing it could tell them something about God.




Thursday


Jesus commanded His followers to help Him return. Decode Matthew 24:13-15 to find out how.

If you do what the ad says, will you be happy, or healthy, or rich, or beautiful? Sometimes. And sometimes, people are a bit happy for a while. But usually the feeling wears off, and then they are looking for something else to make them happy, healthy, rich, or beautiful.

Why do ads work? - Because people are not happy or satisfied on the inside; they don't have the inner peace that comes from God, they know that something is missing inside them, and they hope that they can buy something to fix it.

Last week we learnt that inner peace comes from the armour of God, particularly, the shoes of peace, which protect us from the annoying things around us. The formula from Philippians 4:6 & 7 reminds us that:

His inner peace, which is greater than anything we can imagine.

And when we have this wonderful inner peace - like the shepherds, we will want to spread the news to others.


