Summary: Jesus 1st disciples / followers & Jesus 1st miracle.

Read Before: John 1:35-2:11; Desire of Ages 138-153; 290-297; Bible Story V7 p119-133

Aim: It is good to follow Jesus (His example and His commands)

1. What do I already know? □ Listen / Talk □ See ☑ Do

Play "Do This – Do That". (Like "Simon Says", when you say "Do this" – they must copy you, when you say "Do that" they don't copy).

Options: Younger children will be happy just to "Follow the leader"; with older children you might have them sit down or go to the end of the line when they get it wrong. Let children take turns leading. Finally lead them back, to sit down for the story.

2. Tell story / give facts. □ Listen / Talk ☑ See □ Do

Tell story with felts.

3. Review / how does it apply today? ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☑ Do

Ask: Can we still follow Jesus today? How? What?

(eg. by doing things Jesus did: pray, go to church, help people)

Pillow covers: Jars & "foot print" stamp.



4. What can this become / what can we do? ✓ Listen / Talk ☐ See ✓ Do

Draw or write some things you can do to follow Jesus on the Jesus – Footprints page.

Say: To follow what Jesus did we must learn about Him.

Play the bible game or quiz like last week.
