

Summary: Jesus cleanses the temple. The Official from Capernaum travels to ask Jesus to come and heal his son – Jesus says it is done, and he believes.

Read Before: John 2:13-17; John 4:46-54; Desire of Ages 154-177, 196-200; Bible Story V7 p134-144, 153-156.

Aim: Respect for Church, actions show what you believe. (Actions speak louder than words)

1. *What do I already know?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Play a game of Charades. Give children different bible story's etc to act out (without speaking) while other children guess.

2. *Tell story / give facts.* ☐ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Tell story: Use plastic animals and have children make the appropriate noises.

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

While children do craft, talk about things we might see in church but that we shouldn't. eg. Fighting, unkindness, running, shouting. Are things clean, neat and attractive etc.

Talk about and if possible plan: some of the things the children can do in church, to show God that they love Him.
