

Summary: Jesus uses a boys lunch to feed a crowd.

Read Before: John 6:1-14, Mark 6:30-44, Matt 14:13-21, Desire of Ages 364-371, Bible Story V8 p41-45

Aim: 1. Jesus cares about physical needs. 2. The disciples cleaned up afterwards; they didn't waste the leftovers.

Ask: What did you have for lunch yesterday?

2. *Tell story / give facts.* ☐ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Tell story using felts or a basket etc.

Ask: Can you imagine using your lunch to feed everyone at church today?

Say: Only Jesus could do that. And that day, when Jesus feed the people, there were lots and lots more people there than we ever have at church.

4. *What can this become / what can we do?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Plan: Have an activity planned that the children can do to help meet someone's physical needs. Eg. Help at a soup kitchen, care packages for the homeless, the sick or the missions, collect money for a specific project to help someone, visit the hospital or old people's home, clean up Australia etc.
