

Summary: Jesus tells ten lepers to go to the priests and they will be healed. One leper comes back to say thankyou.

Read Before: Luke 17:11-19; Desire of Ages p348 Bible Story Vol8 p37-40

Aim: To remember to tell God thankyou

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Give the children a small gift or treat and ask what should you say when someone gives you something.

OR have the children talk about gifts and saying thankyou.

2. *Tell story / give facts.* ☐ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Tell story with a chain of paper men

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Have pictures of things God has made that we should be thankful for.

Ask: Who gives us this? Have you thanked Him for it?

4. *What can this become / what can we do?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Craft: Jesus and Me book.

Title Page: Use a digital camera and printer to print a photo of each child, add the title: "Jesus and me" and the picture of Jesus.

Page 1: Use a digital camera and printer to print a photo of each child praying. Cut out chain of men (accordion/zigzag fold paper strip and cut man shape) but use stickers for things to be thankful for.
