

Summary: The last supper – Jesus tells His disciples to follow His example of foot washing, and eating the bread and grape juice.

Read Before: John 13:1-17, Mark 14:12-26, Matt 26:17-30; Desire of Ages p642-661; The Bible Story Vol9 55-64

Aim: Jesus wants me to take part in the communion service so that I will not forget that He died to save me.

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Ask: Why do people have birthdays? (Celebrate to remember their age/birth)

Ask: What do people do for birthdays? ("Happy Birthday", presents, cake, sing etc.)

Ask: How do they get ready for a birthday? (Buy presents, dress for party etc)

Jesus had a special party with His disciples to remind them that He was going to die.

Say: This term we are learning about the things that happened in the last week before Jesus died. Lots of things happened in that week and they all lead up to something very important. Each week we will get one piece of the puzzle and at the end of the term you will see what is so important.
