

Summary: Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane; the disciples keep falling asleep.

Read Before: Matthew 26:36-56, John 18:1-12, Luke 22:47-51, Matthew 14:51-52; Desire of Ages; The Bible Story Vol9 73-81

Aim: When I am worried I will pray. Prayer gives power to do what is right.

Ask: Do you ever worry about stuff? What?

Say: Write or draw something that you worry about

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Say: This term we are learning about the things that happened in the last week before Jesus died. Lots of things happened in that week and they all lead up to something very important. Each week we will get one piece of the puzzle and at the end of the term you will see what is so important.

Puzzle Piece 9: Black piece – add stick of Jesus kneeling and draw trees etc.

4. *What can this become / what can we do?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Summarise Philippians 4:6, 7 (Ask + Thanks → Peace) ie. Tell God what we are worried about; thank Him for all He has done and ask for and receive peace.

If possible, pray individually with each child about what they wrote in part 1. If not, pray as a group.
