

Summary: Jesus told Peter he would betray Him.

Read Before: Matt 26:31-35; Luke 22:54-64; Desire of Ages 698-715; The Bible Story Vol9 82-87

Aim: Jesus will always forgive me when I ask, no matter how bad my sin is.

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☐ Do

Ask: Have you ever had a friend do something to hurt you?

Say: Today we are going to hear about one of Jesus friends who did something really mean to Jesus.

2. *Tell story / give facts.* ☐ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Using the craft puzzle pieces briefly review what each week was about. Remind them that after the last supper, on the way to the garden Jesus told the disciples they would run away. Continue with Peter's story.

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Say: This term we are learning about the things that happened in the last week before Jesus died. Lots of things happened in that week and they all lead up to something very important. Each week we will get one piece of the puzzle and at the end of the term you will see what is so important.
