





Some people say God is a bit like an egg. An egg is made up of three different parts, the shell, the white and the yoke, each part different, but they are all a part of the egg.



## Monday

Imagine trying to describe to a butterfly what it is like to be a human. Imagine trying to describe how big and how strong we are. Imagine trying to describe to a butterfly - which lives only hours, days or at the most a few

months - what it is like to live 70 or 80 years. That would seem like forever to them. It would be impossible for a butterfly to come close to understanding and that must be something like us trying to understand God.
