Junior Discussion Plan Year 3 Quarter 3 Week 9

Aim: To understand what baptism is. Fundamental 15

Resources: What We Believe for Kids by Jerry D Thomas; What We Believe for Teens by Seth J Pierce; God Loves Me 28 ways – Bible Adventures for Young Readers. All published by Pacific Press Publishing Association.

This term we are looking at what the Seventh-day Adventist Church believes. Today we are doing Fundamental 15 – Baptism.

Use the following verses to find the answers to the following questions.

- 1. How was baptism done in the Bible? Matthew 3:1-5, 13-16
- 2. How old were the people being baptised? Matthew 3:5, Luke 3:23
- 3. Read about Jesus command to His followers in Matthew 28:19-20
- 4. What does baptism symbolise?
 - Psalms 15:7 Being washed clean from sin
 - Romans 6:4 The death of our sinful nature and new life in Jesus
 - Romans 6:5 Being united and committed to Christ (kind of like getting married)
- 5. What about people who die before being baptised? The thief on the cross wasn't baptised but Jesus said that he would go to heaven. (Luke 23:39-43)
- 6. Ask: Did you know there are two types of baptism? What did John the Baptist say in Matthew 3:11, Acts 1:4-5 *It is the baptism of the Holy Spirit that is the most important baptism.*
- 7. Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-13 this is the miracle that happens through God's Spirit: many people who are very different become united to work together under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- 8. How often should people be baptised by water? John 13:8-10
- 9. How often should people be baptised with the Holy Spirit? 1 Corinthians 15:31KJV said "I die daily" Everyday we have to spend time with God and ask for the Holy Spirit.
- 10. Read 11:13
