

Aim: To understand what Salvation is and how do I get it? Fundamental 10

This term we are looking at what the Seventh-day Adventist Church believes. Today we are doing Fundamental 10 – Salvation.

Do you know what Salvation means?

- The Cambridge English Dictionary says: a way of being saved from danger, loss, or harm.
- Acts 4:12 – "There is salvation in no one else! God has given no other name under heaven by which we must be saved."

What are we being saved from? (Sin)

- Romans 6:23 – the wages of sin
- Romans 3:22 – all have sinned

Who saves us?

- Luke 19:10 - Jesus

How are we saved?

- Romans 5:10 – Saved by Christ's death while we were enemies of God.
- Acts 16:16 – Believe in the Lord *NOTE: Remember last week we talked about how there are two types of baptism; water baptism and Holy Spirit baptism. Which one is the most important? (Spirit baptism – which means having the Holy Spirit come into your life) That's what happened to the thief on the cross.*
- Titus 2:11,12 – The grace of God offers salvation and teaches how to live

What should I do / am I saved?

- 1 John 1:9 – Confess sins
- Acts 16:16 as above – Believe in Jesus
- Luke 11:13 – Pray for the Holy Spirit everyday
- Proverbs 3:5 – Trust the Lord, not your own understanding.
