

Summary: Jesus speaks to Saul in a bright light, blinding him. Ananias is sent to him and Paul becomes a great leader.

Read Before: Acts 9:1-31, Acts of Apostles 112-130, Early Writings 200-202, Bible Story V10 p42-46

Aim: God changes people.

1. *What do I already know?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Say: Everybody make a happy face; bored face; sad, grumpy, angry, crying, sleepy, interested, excited, and happy!

Ask: Which is the nicest face? (eg. Happy)

Ask: Which face is not the nicest?

Say: Today we are learning how someone changed from being angry to happy and excited.

2. *Tell story / give facts.* ☐ Listen / Talk ☒ See ☐ Do

Tell story with felts or with craft and torch.

3. *Review / how does it apply today?* ☐ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Craft: Happy / Sad puppet.

Draw a happy and a sad face on the backs of two paper side-plates. Put glue around the edge of the right side of the plate and glue wool for hair. Glue the two plates together onto a paddle pop stick.

4. *What can this become / what can we do?* ☒ Listen / Talk ☐ See ☒ Do

Older children: Divided into small groups and plan a drama on a situation where you are sad and how you can change to happy.

Younger children: Ask questions and if the crafts are dry have children use them to answer. If not make the appropriate face to answer.
