
Summary: The Holy Spirit comes like fire. Then Jesus followers can preach in other languages.

Aim: To learn about the Holy Spirit.



Play: "I Spy with my little eyes, something beginning with:"

T – (tables)

P – (pictures)

W – (wind)

Ask: Can you really see the wind? No? – How do you know it is there?

Say: Heres one way. (Demonstrate windmill. Hold up to a fan or move it in a circle around you so that it spins.)

Craft: Fold top of card down at the dotted line. With the top folded down, stick orange spots above the disciple heads.






4. What can this become / what can we do? □ Listen / Talk □ See ☑ Do

Make windmills. Cut coloured paper to a square, cut the diagonals in approx 2/3 of the way to the centre. Punch a hole in the centre, and in the corners as shown. Use glue or tape to attach each of the punched corners into the centre, being careful
