

Summary: Peter & John are thrown in prison, then brought before the priests and told to stop preaching.

Read Before: Acts 4:1-33, Acts of the Apostles 62-69, Bible Story V10 p21-23.

Aim: The Holy Spirit can give me the power to do what is right even when it is not easy.

Experiment: What can power do? Show some different things that a 6V battery can do. (We used an old CPU fan, a computer case fan, a "flashing" LED, a torch bulb, an electro magnet.)

Say: Power can do lots of different things can't it?

Ask: Have you ever done anything scary? (By yourself or did you have help?)

Say: It's easier to do hard things when you have help isn't it?

Draw: a picture of doing the hard thing.

Say: The disciples did something that was scary but they didn't act afraid because they knew that they had the Holy Spirit to help them.

Tell the story using felts or the craft.

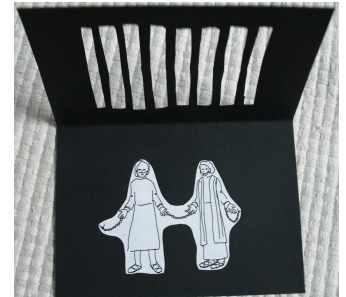
3. *Review / how does it apply today?*
