Helmut Haubeil in his book 'Steps to Personal Revival' (which is available for free from <u>steps-to-personal-revival.info</u> suggests the following reasons why a person might be lacking the Holy Spirit:

- Ignorance
- Unbelief, or small faith
- Incorrect ideas eg. thinking they already have the Holy Spirit.
  Too busy for a personal relationship.
- Hidden sins
- Going by feelings rather than faith.
- Mistrust, fear where God will lead, not trusting God's love and wisdom, fear of the unknown.

The wisdom of God is opposite from the wisdom of this world. Give God a tithe of your money, and instead of having less, you will have more. Give God more of your time, and you will get a lot more done.

Some people are afraid to ask for the Holy Spirit, because they think they will lose their free will, and power of choice, but the opposite is true – when God works in our lives, we have more self-control and more freedom.

I have a picture that I often show in Sabbath School, of a boy thinking about stealing, and when you hold the picture up to the light, you see two angels next to him, a yellow angel and a grey angel. I say, "If he listens to the yellow angel, it's as if the yellow angel gets bigger and louder and it is easier to hear God's voice next time he is tempted and harder to hear the grey angel. That voice of God that we hear, is His Holy Spirit. Ask God for the Holy Spirit to work in your life and you will never regret it.

#### 3 Testimonies:

A certain businessman shared how health seminars hadn't done him any good. But since he started to daily pray for the Holy Spirit, he had completely shifted to a healthy lifestyle.

A sister read this experience. She wrote: Through my complete surrender to Jesus, God changed my life completely, in a moment. After my prayer of surrender I went into the kitchen the next morning, stood by the coffee machine, shook my head, and said to myself: 'No, I don't drink coffee anymore.' In the past this would have been unthinkable, because when I tried to quit coffee, I had had horrible headaches for five days. Today I have no more desire for coffee. This was one of many changes.

A young man was really struggling. The pastor asked, "Have you completely submitted your will to God?"

"I don't think I have, I'm afraid."

"Well", said the pastor, "It won't do any good to pray to be filled with the Holy Spirit, till you have completely submitted your will to God. Don't you want to submit to God now?" "I can't", he replied.

"Are you willing for God to do it for you?"

"Yes", he answered.

"Then ask Him to do it."

He prayed: "Oh God, empty me from my own will. Bring me into complete submission to your will. Lay down my will for me. I pray in Jesus' name."

Then the pastor asked: "Did it happen?"

"It must have", he said. "I asked God for something according to His will and I know that He answered me and that I have what I prayed for (1 John 5:14-15). It has happened."

Then the pastor said: "Now pray for the baptism of the Holy Spirit."

He prayed: "Oh God, baptize me now with Your Holy Spirit. I pray in Jesus' name." And it happened immediately when he laid down his will."



1Timothy 2:9 and Deuteronomy 22:5 and 1 Peter 3:3, 4, remembering that what was culturally appropriate has change since then.



They should wear <u>decent</u> and <u>appropriate</u> clothing and not draw attention to themselves by the way they fix their hair or by wearing gold or pearls or expensive clothes." NLT

Deuteronomy 22:5 warns that women should not <u>dress</u> as men nor men as women.

1 Peter 3:3,  $4_{\text{NLT}}$  "Don't be concerned about the <u>outward</u> beauty of fancy <u>hairstyles</u>, expensive jewellery, or <u>beautiful</u> clothes. You should clothe yourselves instead with the beauty that comes from within, the

unfading beauty of a <u>gentle</u> and <u>quiet spirit</u>, which is so precious to God." Fit the underlined

Jesus Himself said that even thinking about breaking a Commandment was breaking it! 1 John  $3:15_{NLT}$  says, "Anyone who hates another brother or sister is really a murderer at heart." In Ephesians  $5_{NLT}$ , Paul also mentions impurity, greed, obscene stories and jokes, and drunkenness. Instead, Christians should be aiming to become more and more like Christ.




Yesterday we looked at the Fruit of the Spirit which God wants to grow in our lives, and also some of the things that God does not want in us.
