

Let's choose seven men who are well respected and are full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom. We will give them the responsibility of looking after the believer's physical needs; then we apostles can spend our time in <u>prayer</u> and teaching the word."

Everyone liked this idea, and they chose seven men including Stephen. Stephen was a man full of God's <u>grace</u> and <u>power</u>, and he performed amazing miracles; he also had great <u>wisdom</u> and no one could argue with him.



# **Thursday**


Stephen chose to do the right thing no matter what.


