From **Philippi** they walked to **Amphilipolis**, and from there they walked to **Apollonia**. After that they walked to **Thessalonica**. Lots of people here believed in Jesus, but other people caused trouble and the Christians were given fines because of it. That night left to go to **Berea**.

There was something special about the people in **Berea**, every day Paul preached to them and every day they went home and got out the Bible scrolls and read them to make sure that everything Paul told them was true.

Some people from Thessalonica followed to make trouble so Silas and Timothy stayed behind to keep preaching while Paul travelled ahead on a boat to **Athens**.

There were lots of temples and alters to idols in Athens. Paul even saw an alter to "The Unknown God". Paul told the people that he wanted to tell them about the unknown God, and then he told them about Jesus. But only a few people believed him, so he travelled on to Corinth where he stayed with a couple named Aquila and Priscilla and helped them make tents to sell.
