Summary: Paul is warned not to go to Jerusalem, but does. He tells of his work and the leaders are happy but some people spread rumours, so Paul is advised to join some Christians in a ceremony at the temple. He is recognised by some Asians, who start riot but Paul is saved by some soldiers. The Jews keep plotting to kill him and he is in jail for more than 2 years. King Agrippa almost believes in Jesus then Paul appeals to be sent to Rome.
