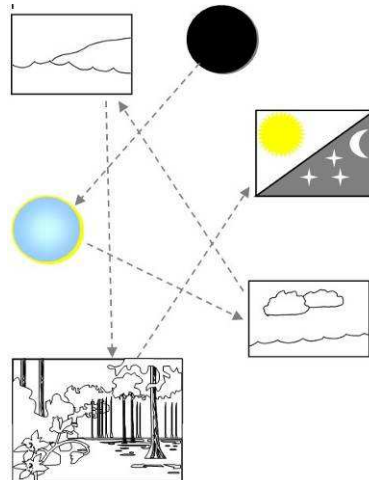

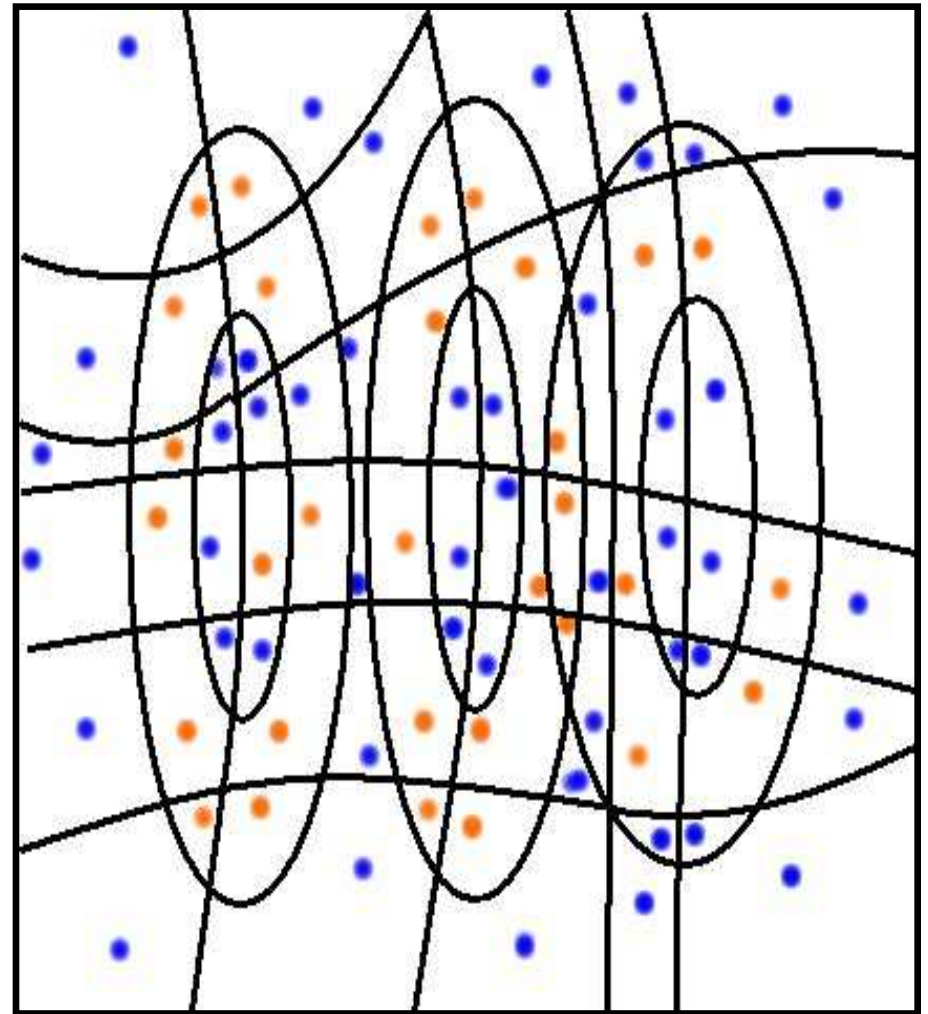

Do you know who made our world?

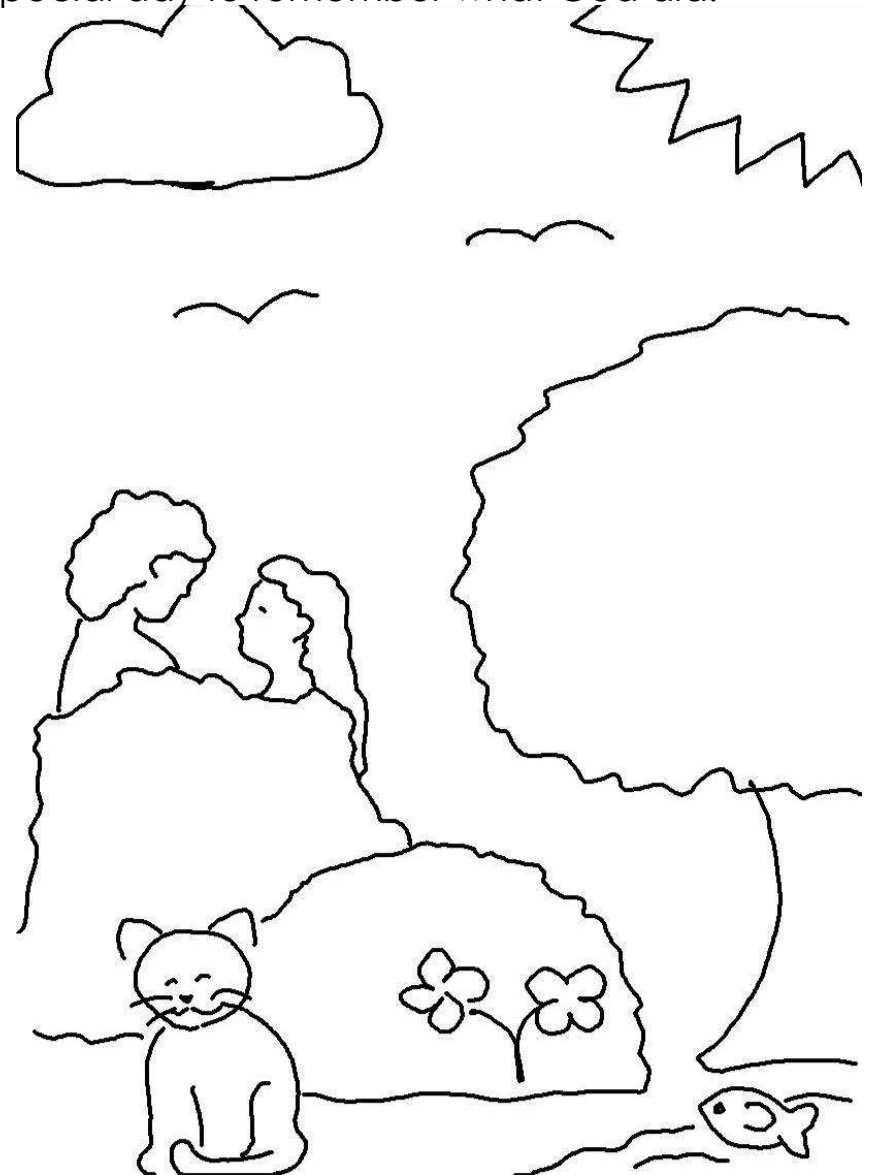

Friday

In just six days God created everything, and then He rested on the seventh day. Every Sabbath is a special day to remember what God did.



Thursday

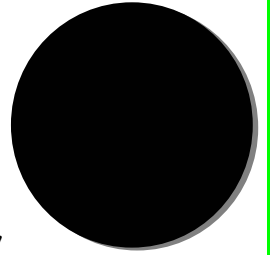
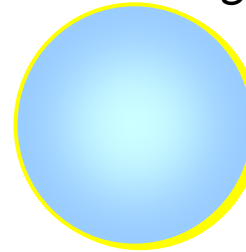
Sunday

On the second day Jesus said "Let there be space between the waters." And there was space, and Jesus called the space the sky.

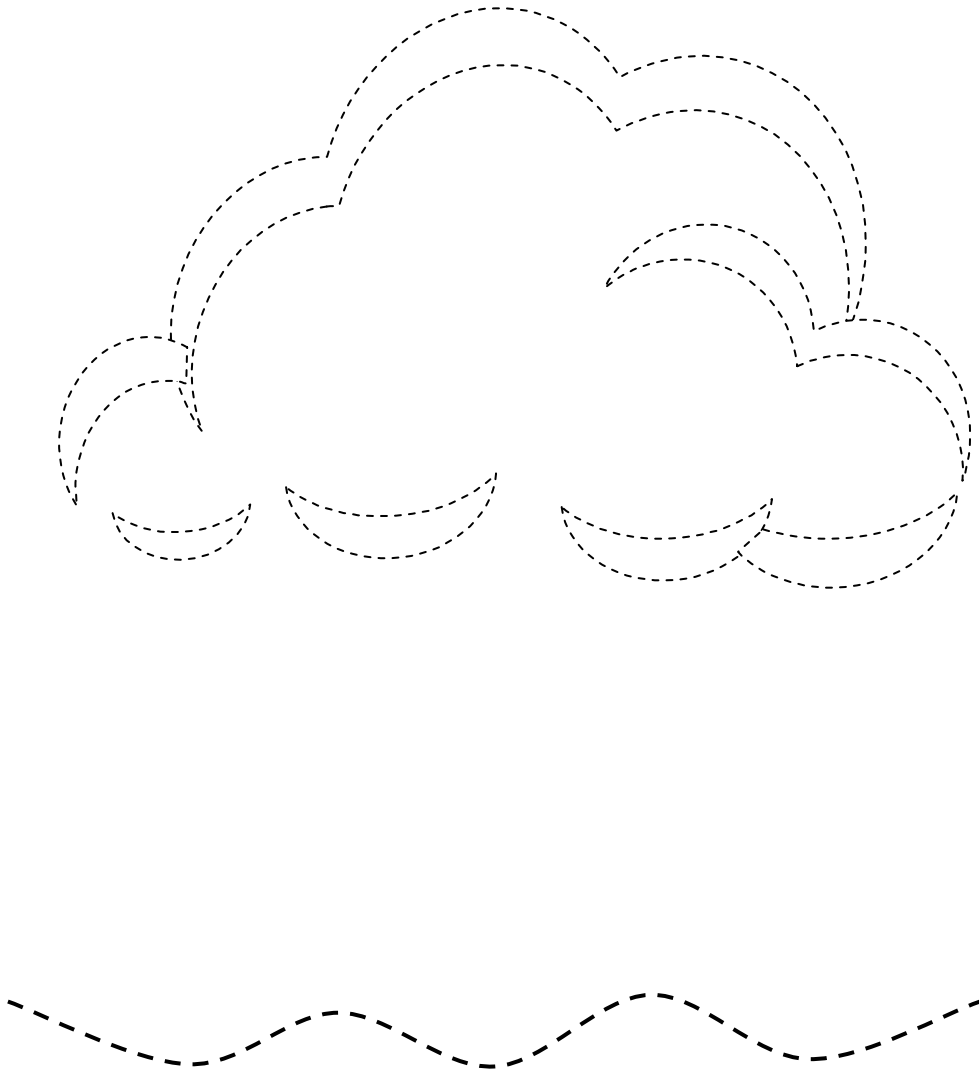
In that space is the air that we need to breathe to stay alive, the wind that we feel on our skin, and the clouds we see in the sky.

Here are some things you might do on Sabbath.



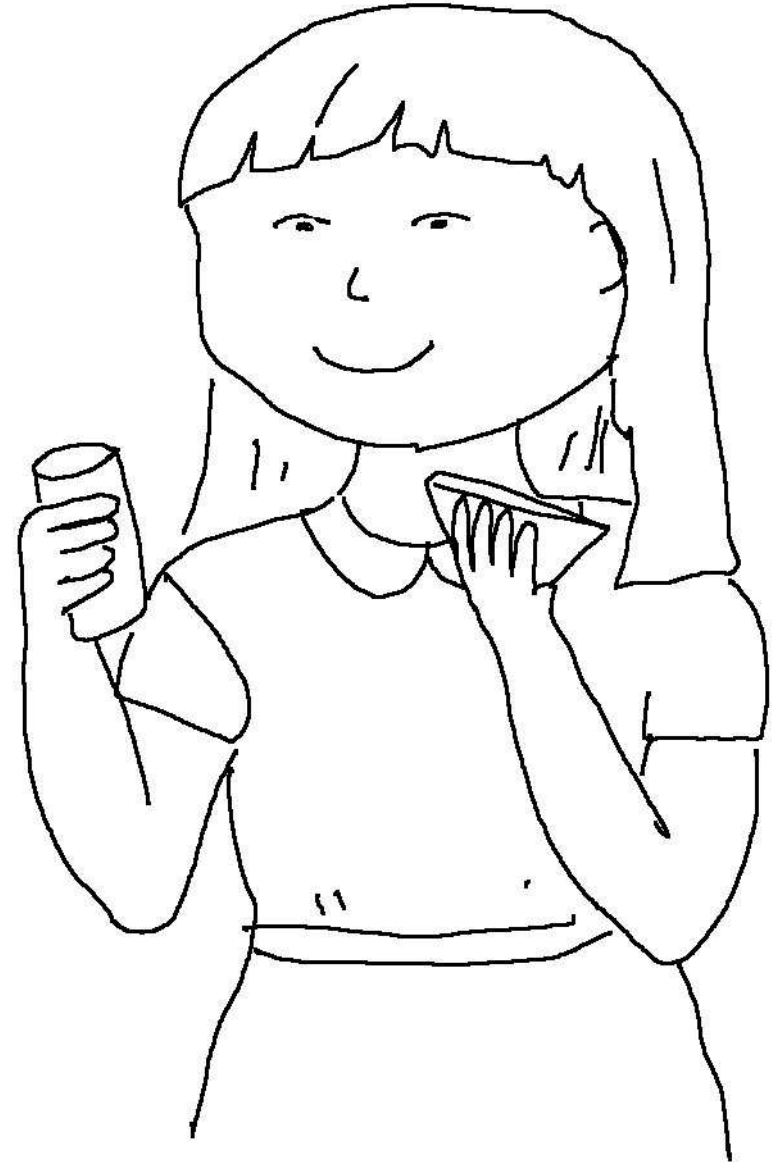
Tuesday

The Bible tells us all about Jesus and how He kept Sabbath when He lived on earth.



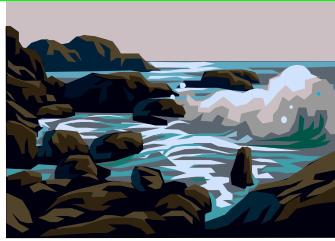

God knows just what we need to live. He gives us air to breath and water to drink.

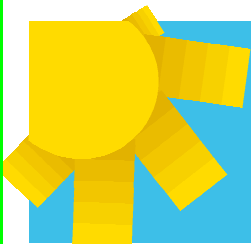


Wednesday

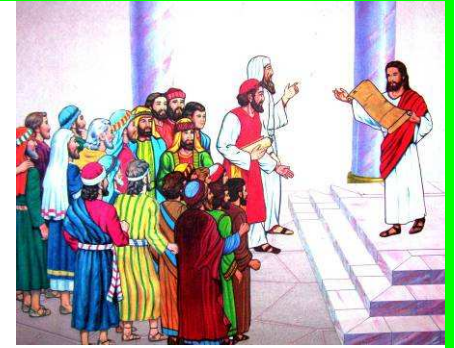

The Bible tells us that when Jesus came to live on this earth He still kept the Sabbath day holy. He would go to church each week to meet with God, His Father.



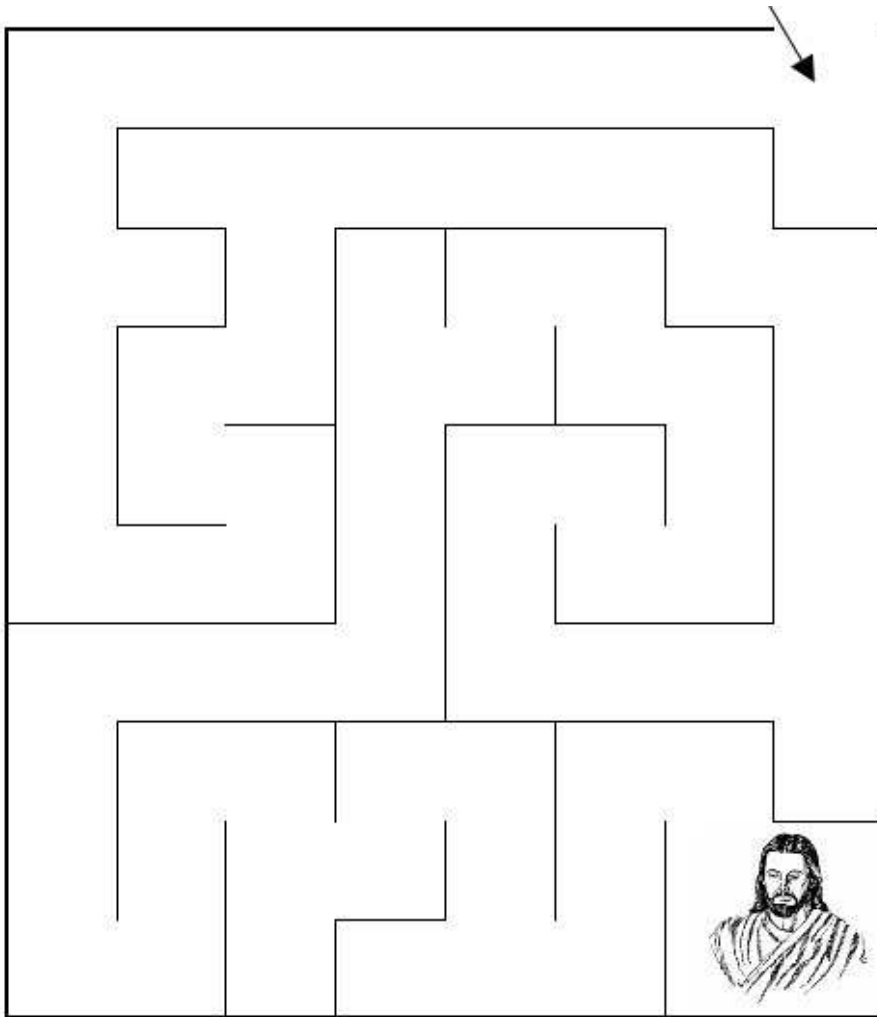
If Jesus could do something to help someone on the Sabbath, such as making a sick person well, He did.

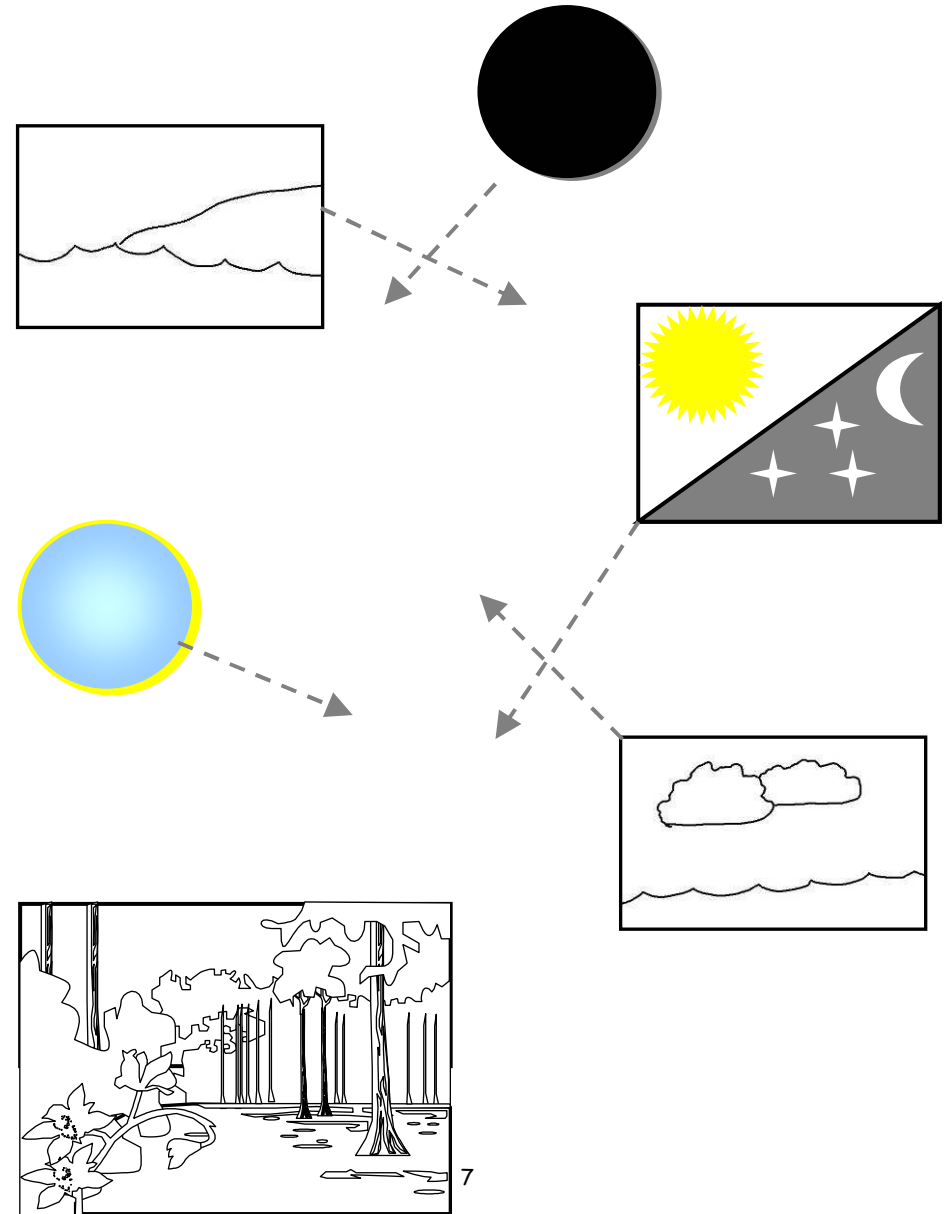
Sunday

Jesus spent the Sabbath day with Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden. Find the way through the maze to Jesus.



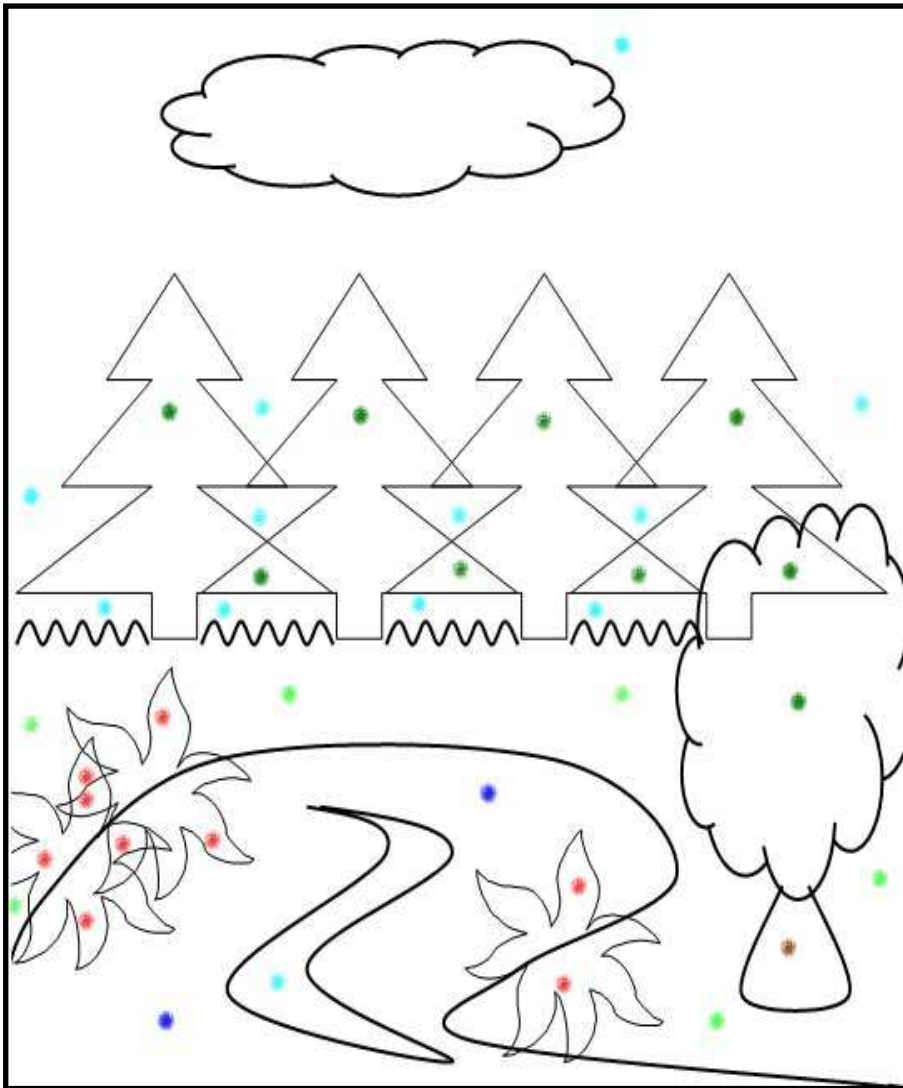

Extend the arrows to join the things that God created in the correct order. The answer is on the back page.



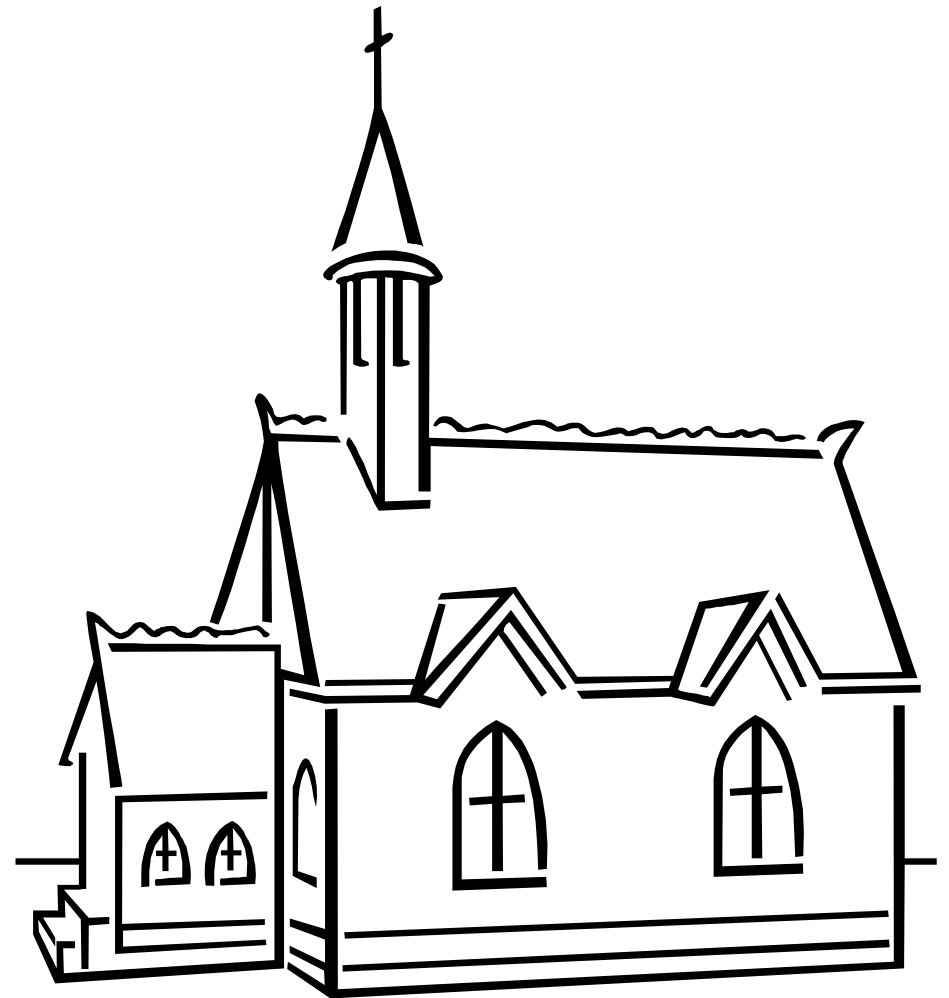

Jesus wants to spend time with us each Sabbath, just as He did with Adam and Eve on that very first Sabbath.

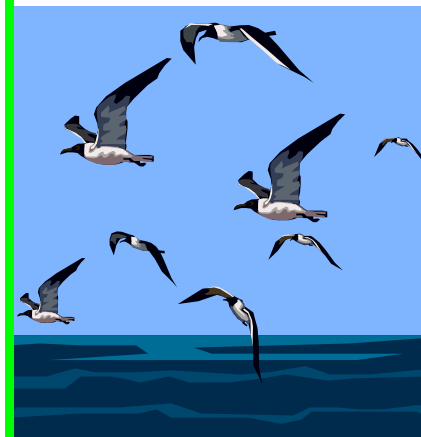


Sabbath

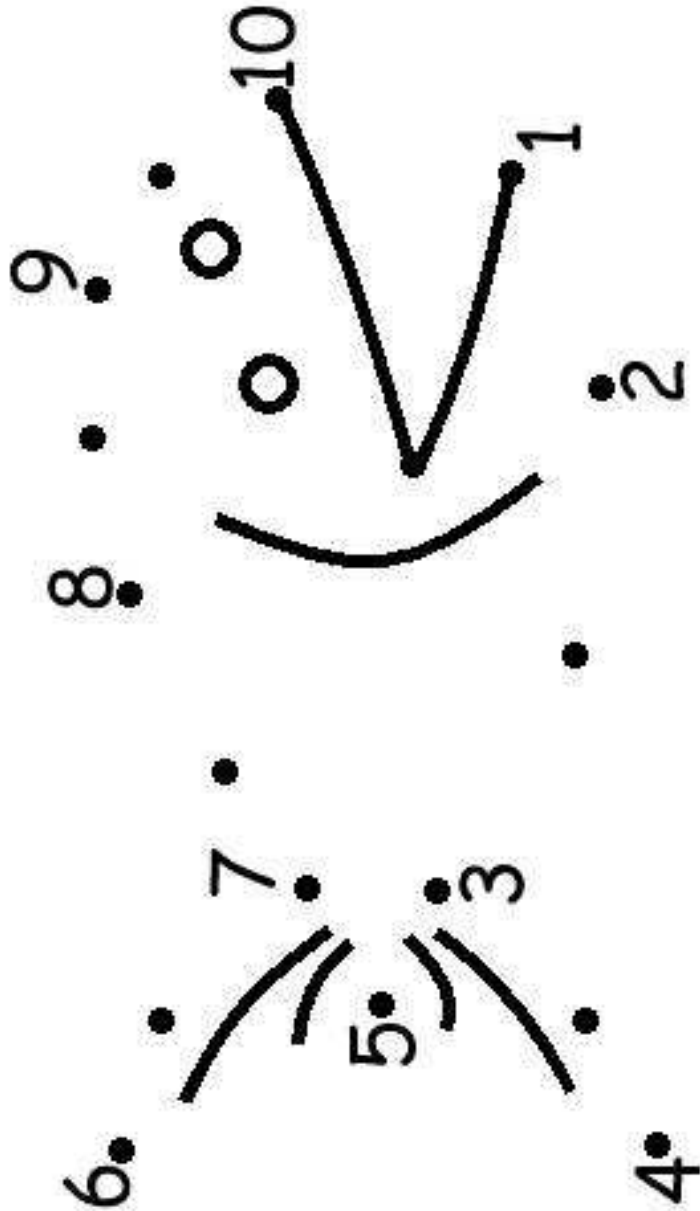


Jesus was very pleased with what He had made. He told the fish and birds to have lots of babies that are just like themselves.

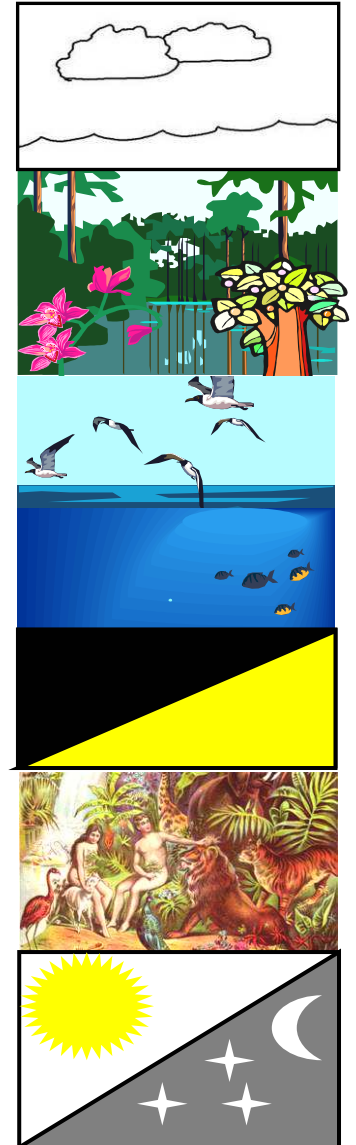

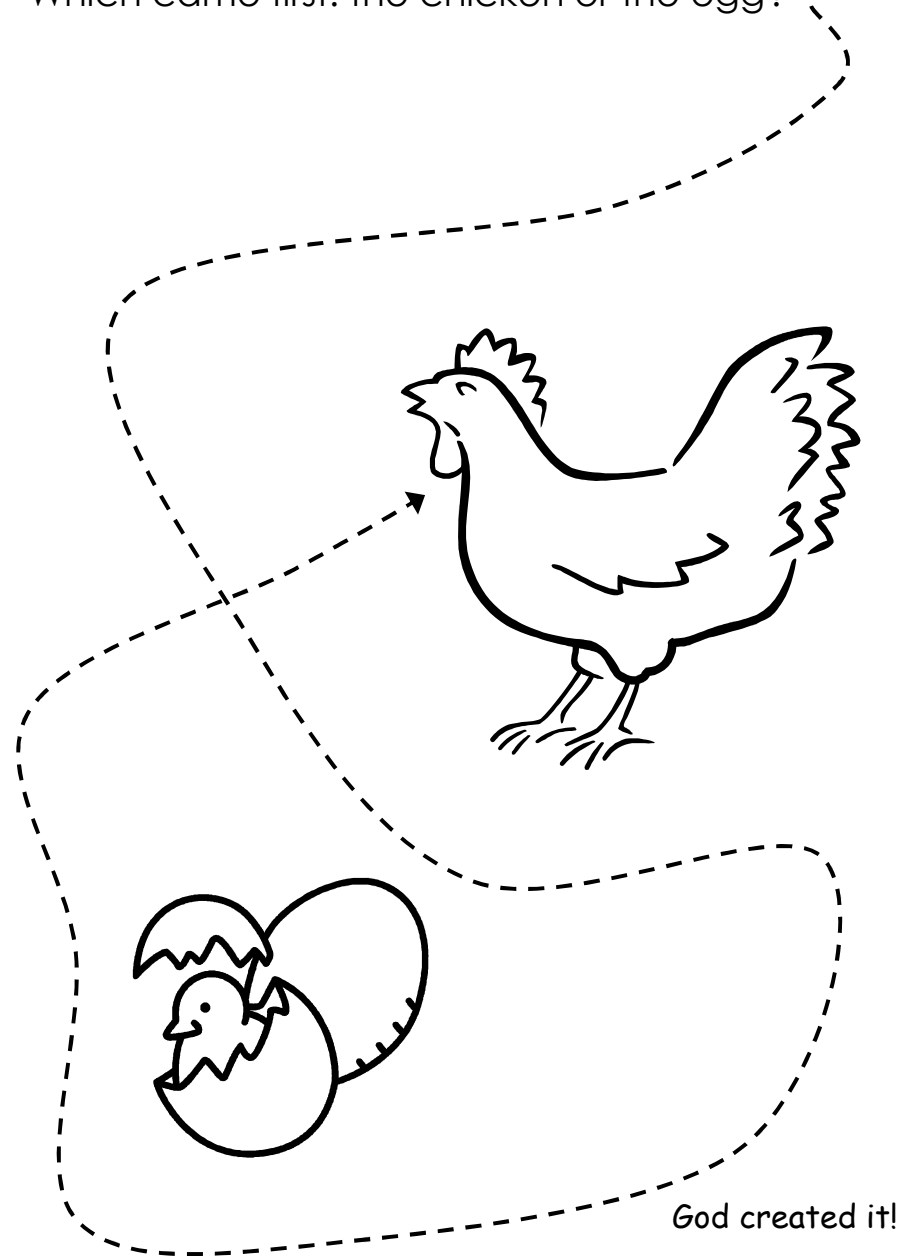
Wednesday
