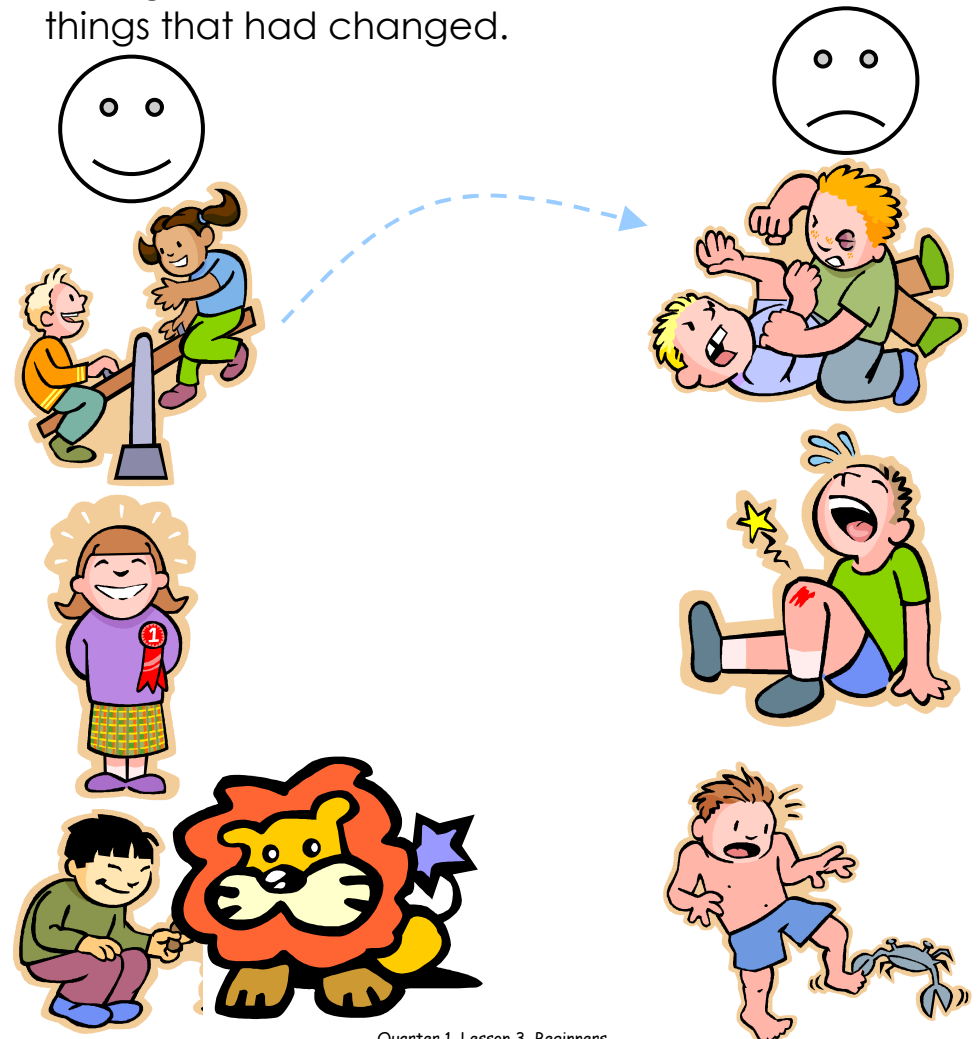

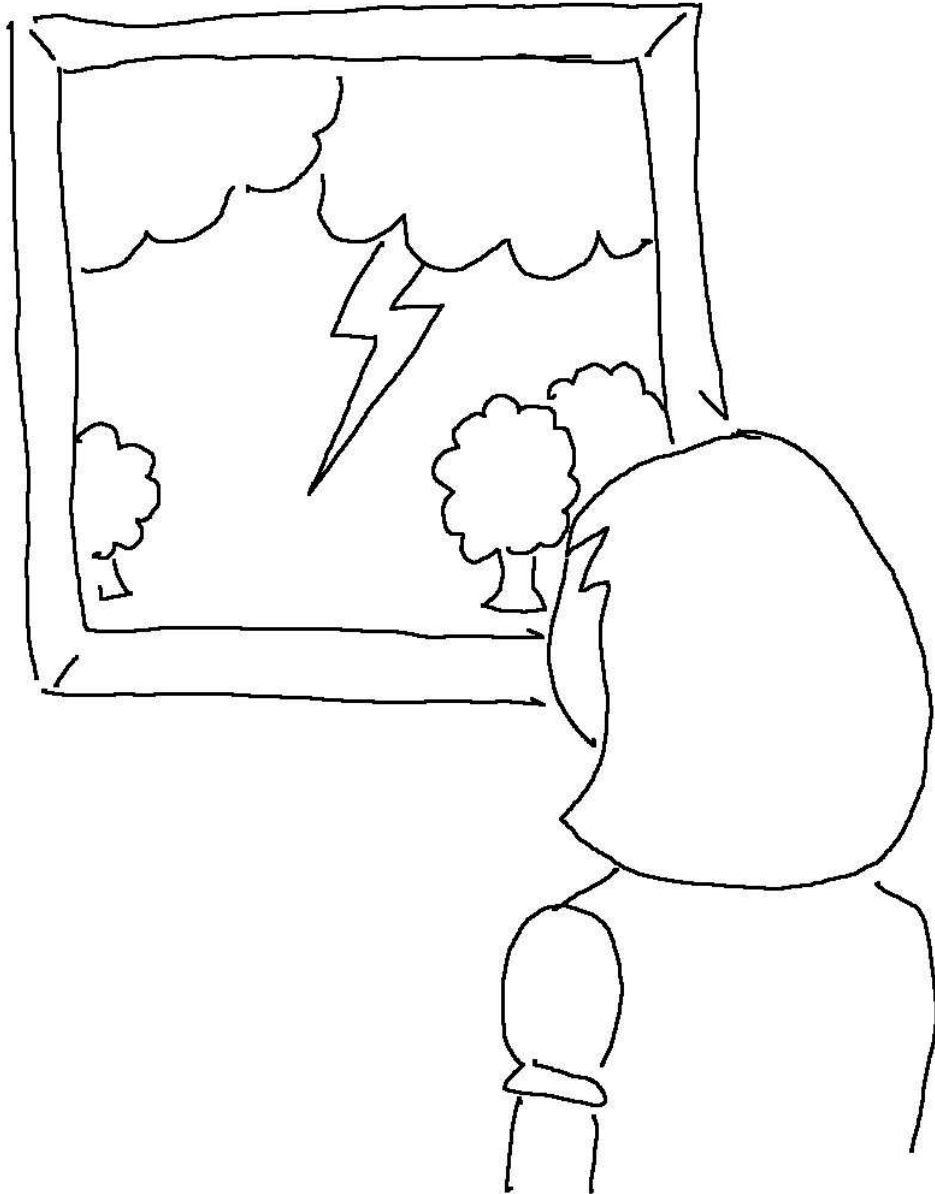
Friday

God looked after Noah in the flood. God will look after you too.



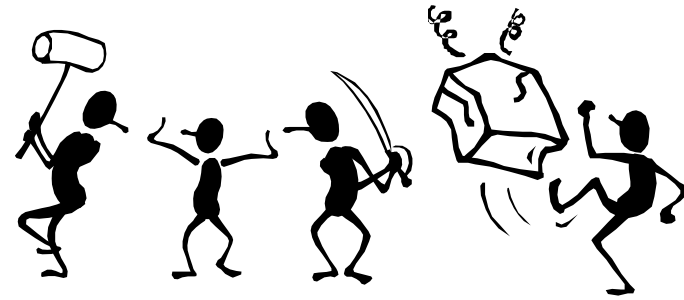
Sunday

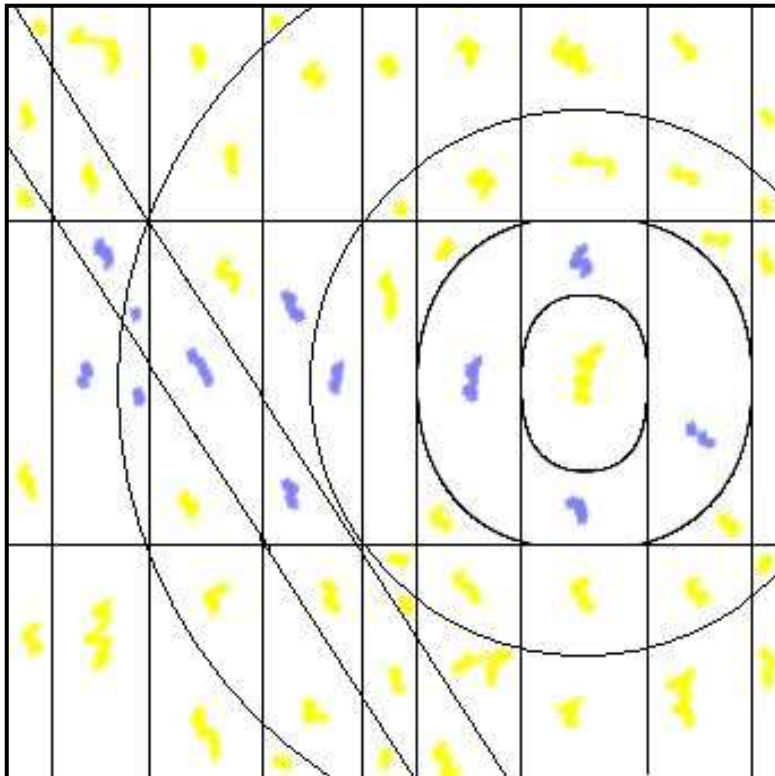

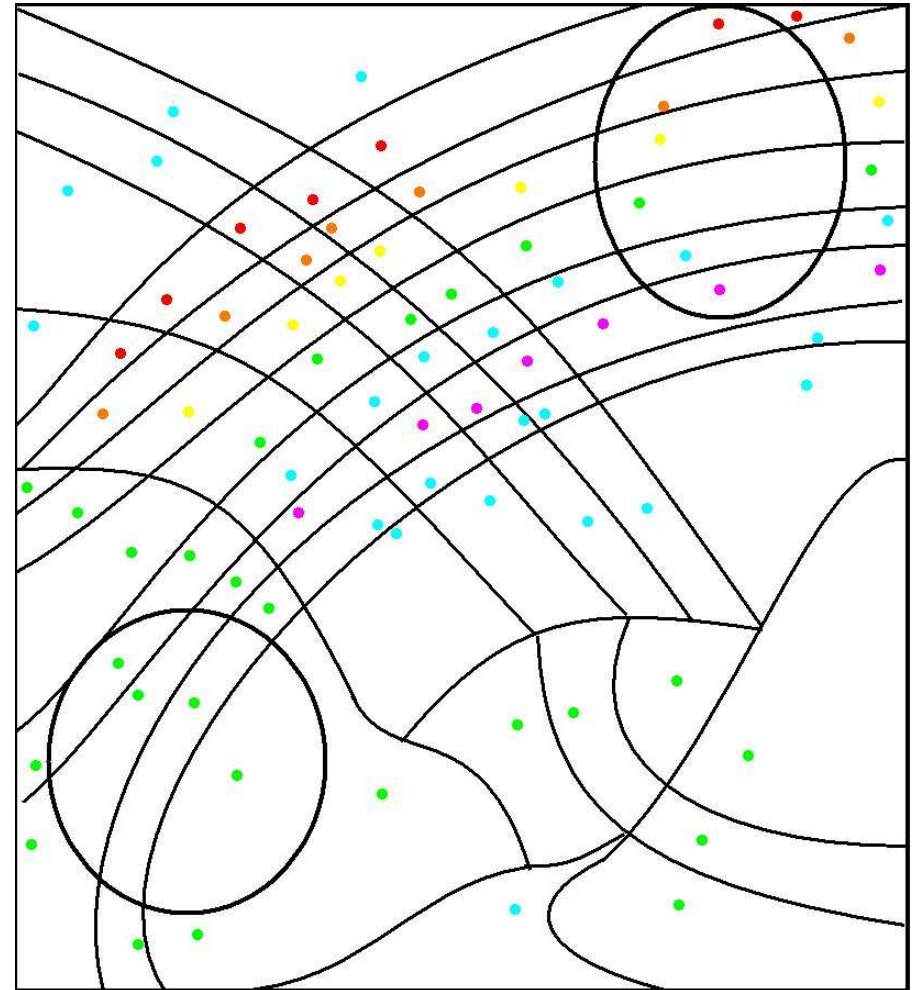

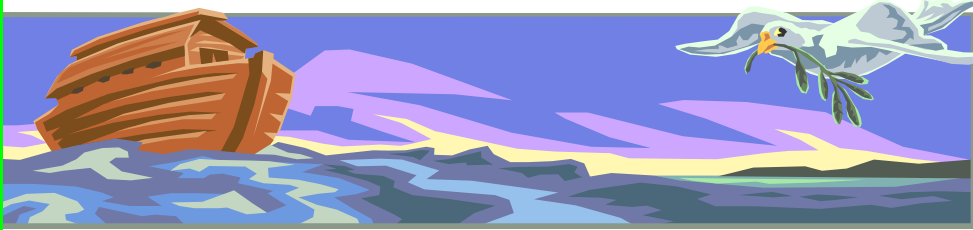
Wednesday

As the water started to go down, angels guided the ark between some mountain tops where it was calm.



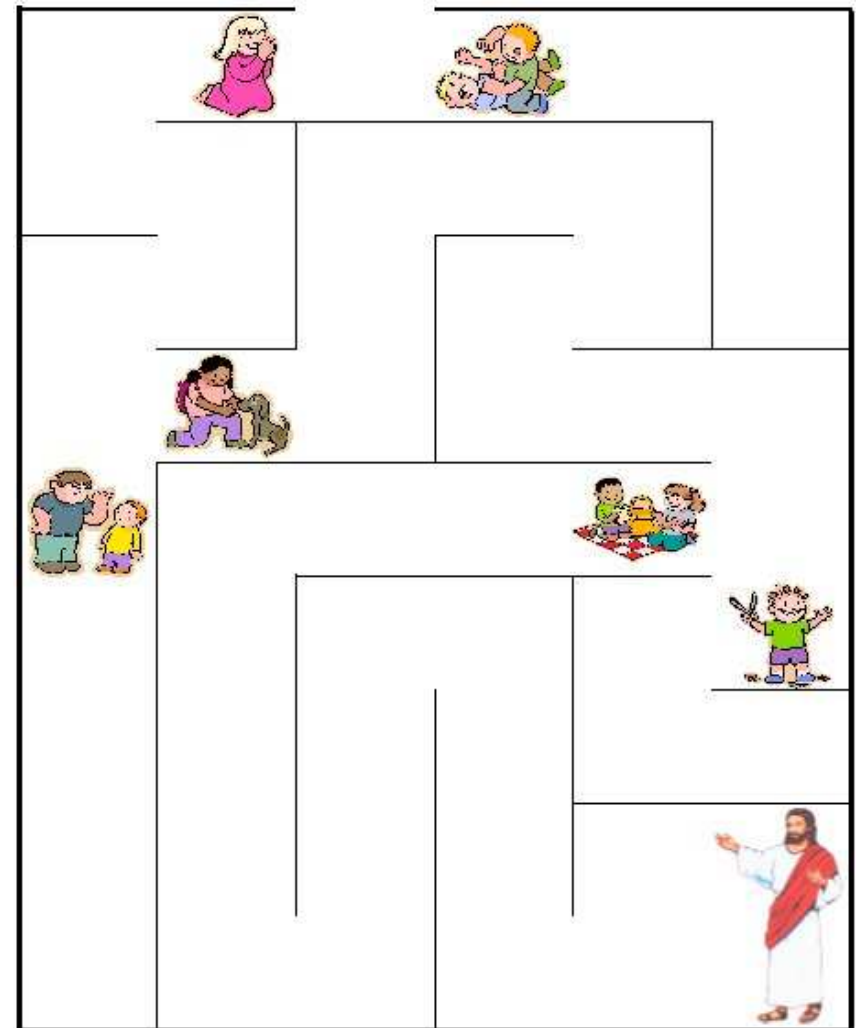

The people just laughed and kept on doing the wrong things.

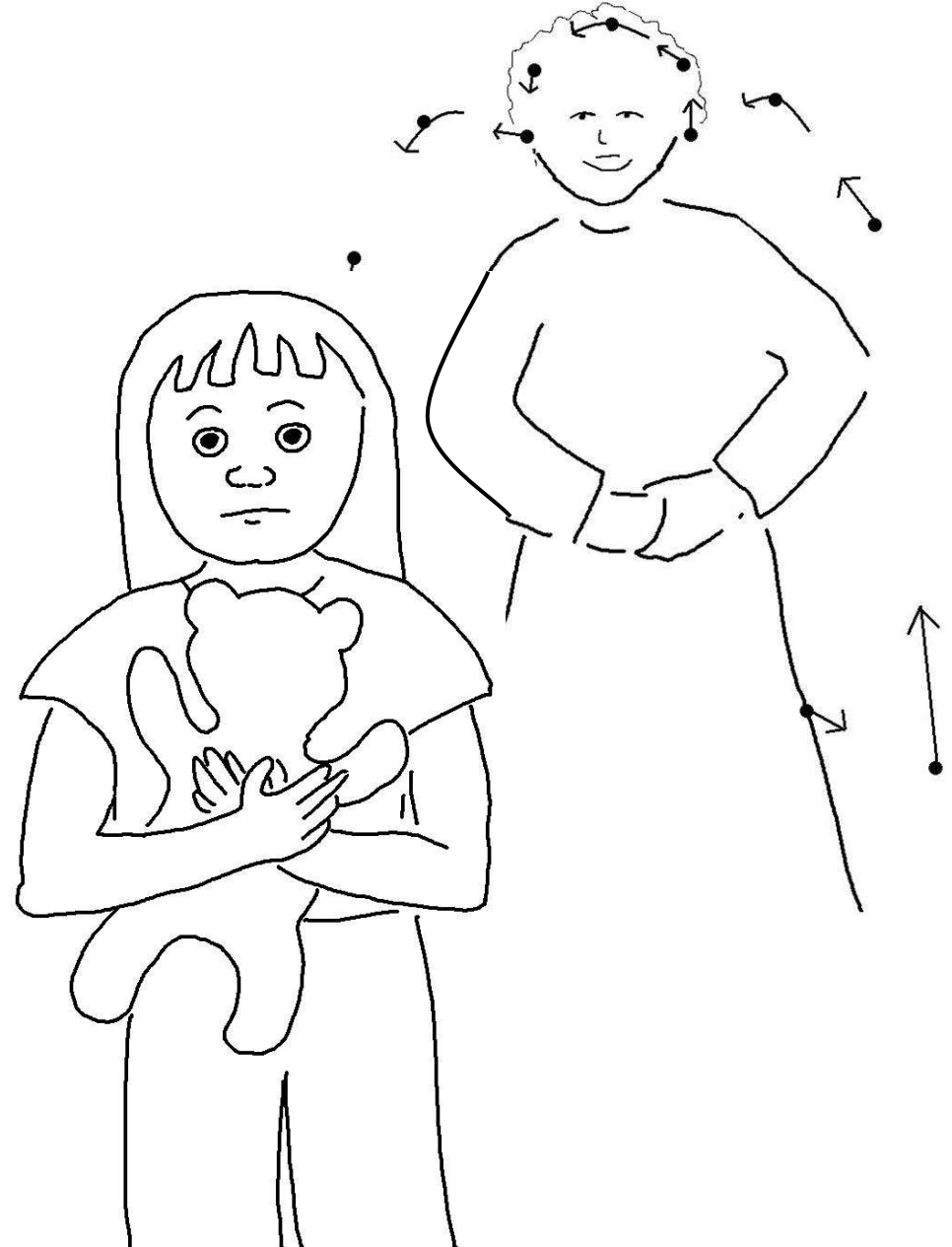

them to do.

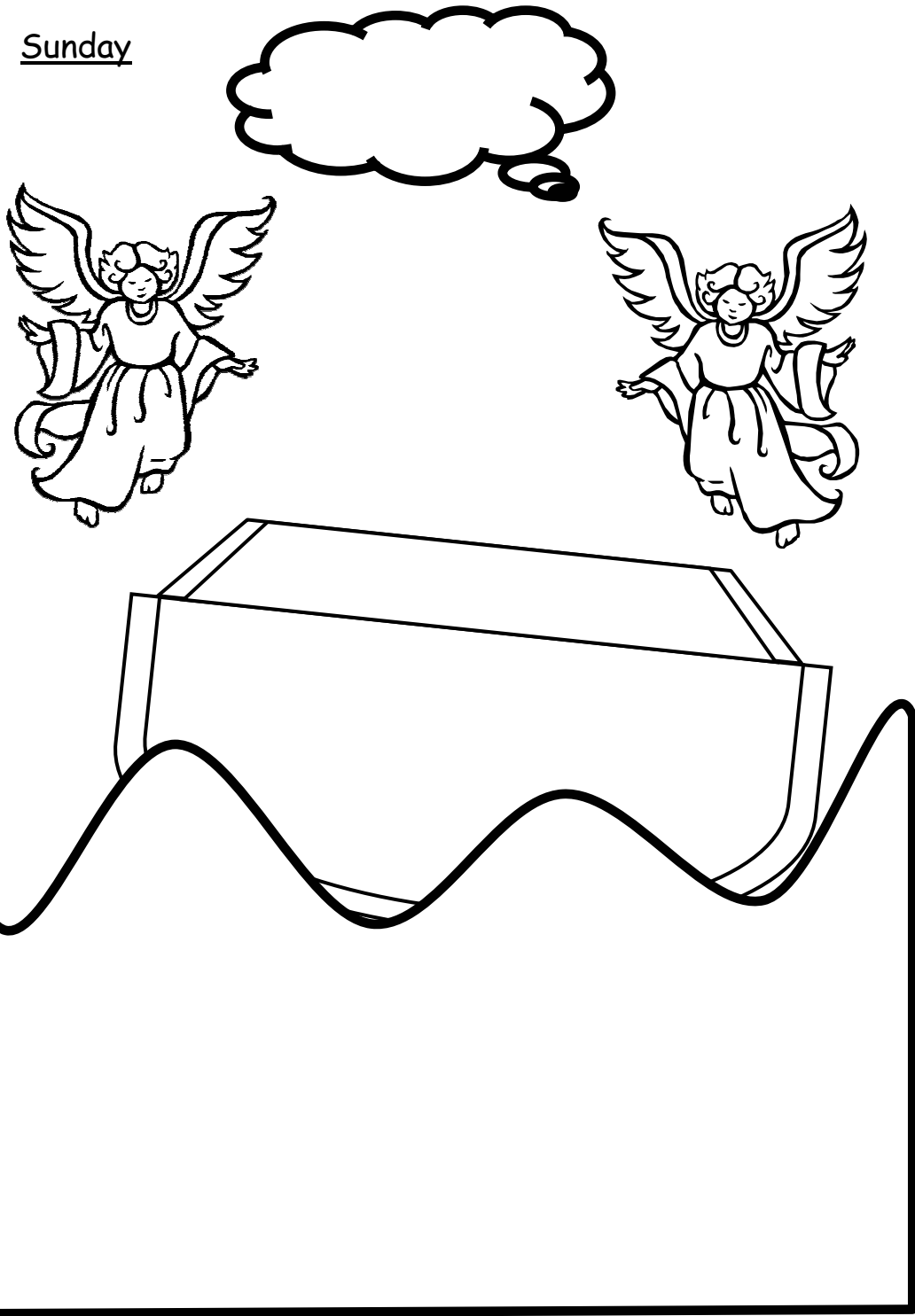
