Lesson Aim: God made us with the power of choice. When bad things happen to us we need to remember that God is leading and to trust in His leading. If we could see the end from the beginning we would know that God is leading us in the way that is best for our eternal salvation.

CRAFT

Week 1.

Paste strips of coloured paper onto the back of the coat pattern then turn over and cut out into coat shape with tabs. Colour in Joseph's hair and cut around him. Place coat onto Joseph. - Can be kept in the envelope with the rainbow.

Week 2.

Colour in the pictures on the one sheet. Cut out the circle including the square. Using a pin, pin the two circles together with the blank circle on top. Turn so that you can see one picture at a time to tell Joseph's story.
