We need to teach our children that God sends His angels to watch over us at all times.





God had a special plan for Moses to rescue the Israelites from slavery in Egypt, and He watched over him to keep him safe.


He gave him parents to teach him all about Jesus and the things that had happened in the world.

So for the first three months they hid him in the house. When he cried they would say, "Shh baby,


don't cry. We don't want the soldiers to find you and throw you into the

God made the world; the first sin; Noah and the flood; and how Joseph came to live in Egypt.



Mother set the basket down among the reeds and she went home. Miriam stayed hiding in the reeds to see what would happen.


Angels that she couldn't see were also there




watching over the baby in his basket boat. God had big plans for that special baby and was keeping watch over him.
