
<u>Sabbath</u>


<u>Friday</u>

Hannah was very sad because she didn't have any children.





smile.


He obeyed Priest Eli, and each day Samuel and Priest Eli would read the Bible stories and learn about all the things God had done.

Can you be like Samuel and do what mummy and daddy ask you with a smile on your face?






Samuel was happy to help in the Sanctuary. He loved his God and his Mummy and Priest Eli. What did his Mummy bring him every year?
